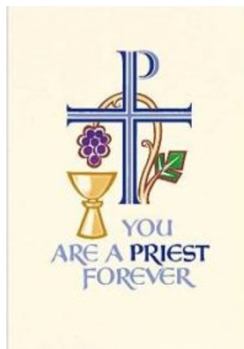
FATHER'S DAY PRAYER
