Dear Parishioners:

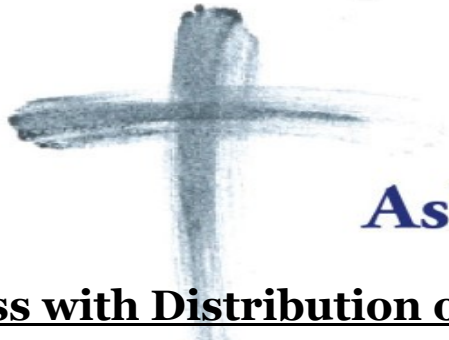
