Prayer, Fasting and Charity

This season focuses on these three pillars of Lent that help us prepare for Easter.

First Sunday of Lent: February 28
Second Sunday of Lent: March 1
Third Sunday of Lent: March 8
Fourth Sunday of Lent: March 15
Fifth Sunday of Lent: March 22

The three pillars of Lent:

- **Prayer:** Intensify, attend daily Mass or the Stations of the Cross.
- **Fasting:** Self-denial that helps us focus on spiritual needs rather than physical ones.
- **Charity:** Sharing resources with those in need, for example, donating money saved during fasting.

During Lent, Catholics (ages 18 to 59) must fast and abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, while those over 14 abstain from eating meat every Friday.
