St. Vincent Martyr has a wonderful opportunity to help the Women at Edna Mahan Correctional Facility on the weekend of November 6th. The woman's prison has recently opened a "Children's room" for children and their incarcerated mother to visits and spend some quality time together. They had been using a large meeting room that did not provide for a natural environment. They are currently working on a new room for women in the maximum security facility too. This is a chance for us to show compassion to incarcerated women and their families during this Year of Mercy.

The woman's prison is looking for games, toys, crafts, and books for children of all ages to fill these new visiting rooms. The toys/items need to be new and in their original packaging. The following are approved items:

- Board Game: (no dice or fake money) Candy Land, Clue, Chutes and Ladders, Checkers, Chess, Jinga (stacking tower game), Pictionary, etc
