

El Espíritu Santo enciende corazones

Aquel que da sonoridad vibrante e incisividad a nuestra frágil palabra humana, incluso capaz de mentir y escapar de sus responsabilidades, es solo el Espíritu Santo, a través del cual se generó el Hijo de Dios; el Espíritu que lo ungió y lo sostuvo en la misión; El Espíritu, dijo, gracias al cual escogió a sus apóstoles y quien les garantizó su proclamación de perseverancia y fecundidad, como también hoy los garantiza a los nuestros.

"El Evangelio se concluye con la resurrección y ascensión de Jesús, y a partir de ahí el libro de los Hechos de los Apóstoles nos narra la sobreabundancia de la vida del Resucitado en la Iglesia. El bautismo en el Espíritu Santo permite que entremos en una comunión personal con Dios y que participemos en su voluntad salvífica universal, adquiriendo la capacidad de pronunciar una palabra que sea limpia, libre, eficaz, llena de amor a Dios y a los demás". El bautismo en el Espíritu Santo, de hecho, afirmó el Santo Padre, es la experiencia que nos permite entrar en una comunión personal con Dios y participar en su voluntad salvífica universal, adquiriendo el don de la parresia, es decir, la capacidad de pronunciar una palabra "como hijos de Dios".

Con el bautismo entramos en comunión personal con Dios

Por lo tanto, señaló el Papa, no hay luchar para ganar o merecer el don de Dios. Todo se da gratis y a su debido tiempo. Frente a la ansiedad de saber de antemano el momento en que sucederán los eventos que anunció, Jesús responderá a los suyos: «No les corresponde a ustedes conocer el tiempo y el momento que el Padre ha establecido con su propia autoridad. Pero recibirán la fuerza del Espíritu Santo que descenderá sobre ustedes, y serán mis testigos en Jerusalén, en toda Judea y Samaría, y hasta los confines de la tierra».

"El Resucitado hace que vivamos el tiempo presente sin temor ante lo que acontecerá, porque Dios se manifiesta en el hoy de la historia y nos invita a reconocerle allí. Nos enseña a no fabricarnos una misión particular a nuestra medida, sino a pedir mediante la oración perseverante que el Padre nos dé la fuerza misionera para llegar a todo el mundo y vivir en comunión con los hermanos".

En esta expectativa, los apóstoles viven juntos, como la familia del Señor, en la sala superior o cenáculo, cuyos muros aún son testigos del regalo con el que Jesús se entregó a sí mismo en la Eucaristía. ¿Y cómo aguardan la fortaleza, los dýnamis de Dios? Orando con perseverancia, como si no hubiera tantos sino uno. De hecho, es a través de la oración que uno supera la soledad, la tentación, la sospecha y abre su corazón a la comunión. La presencia de las mujeres y de María, la madre de Jesús, intensifica esta experiencia: primero aprendieron del Maestro a dar testimonio de la fidelidad del amor y la fuerza de la comunión que supera todo temor.
