It was about a month ago when Bridget, our school secretary, approached me with a bit of news that I could tell she was hesitant to share. "I have something I want you to think about," she said, in the way you say something when you don't know how the listener will react. She went on to tell me that the town was looking at the pine tree between the church and the rectory for this year's Madison Christmas Tree. My immediate reaction was not particularly favorable. After all, I am very fond of that tree and love the way it looks when we light it up at Christmas. But then I started thinking -doesn't St. Vincent Martyr claim to be a Catholic presence in Madison since the 1860's, and beyond that, wouldn't it be truly wonderful to gift the town with our beautiful tree in this year that we are so in need of the Christmas spirit! Our tree will stand as a sign of the hope that came into the world at the birth of our Savior – a hope that is meant for all people of good will. It will be a symbol of the peace on earth that Jesus came to establish and that He asks us to grow in our nation and our world. Our tree will shine as light in darkness reminding us to let our lights shine through as acts of kindness, care and compassion. It will bring Joy to the hearts of all who look upon it, a joy that Jesus wants us to complete by sharing His love with others. I guess by now you know that I said "YES" to the town. SUPPLY DRIVE FOR VETERANS



In honor of Veterans Day 2020 the SVM Veterans Ministry is sponsoring a supplies drive. Our Veterans on the VA campus at Lyons have most of their recreation events put on hold during the pandemic and this is expected to continue through the new year. They are also very busy in the VA domiciliary / homeless shelter.

Here are details:

Items: Men's cotton undershirts size Medium to XXXL (must be unworn, but opened is ok); Men's sweat pants size Medium to XXXL; and local supermarket (Stop & Shop, Shop Rite, etc.) gift cards to allow VA staff to prepare holiday meals / parties at VA facilities.

Logistics: Due to Covid, we cannot use the Church or school building for gathering the supplies so deliveries can be made one of three ways: (1) supplies need to be dropped this weekend November 7/8 in the Rectory garage; (2) supplies may be left in the bin on the front porch at Bill Heskett's home (66 Union Hill in Madison) between November 2nd and November 8th. Please email or text when you drop items so we can bring them out of the weather periodically; or (3) we can arrange contactless pickup of items at your address on November 9th or 10th. Please text or email me with pickups specifying address and time of pickup.

El Papa: ¡Señor, dame esperanza!

La esperanza no defrauda, sino que nos atrae, y da un sentido a nuestra vida: ella es el don de Dios que nos atrae hacia la vida y la alegría eterna. En la Conmemoración de los fieles difuntos el Santo Padre Francisco celebró la Santa Misa en la Iglesia del Camposanto Teutónico del Vaticano. La homilía improvisada del Sumo Pontífice fue un himno a la esperanza, "regalo de Dios y ancla" de la que debemos sujetarnos en los momentos más oscuros de nuestra vida.

La esperanza cristiana, don de Dios

El Papa realizó su reflexión partiendo del pasaje de la Primera Lectura de la liturgia de hoy, tomado del Libro de Job, que narra el término de su existencia a causa de la enfermedad. Con la piel deshecha casi al punto de morir, casi sin carne, Job – dijo el Papa – tiene una certeza y la dice: “Yo sé que mi Redentor vive y que, al fin, se levantará sobre el polvo”. En el momento en que el profeta está “más abatido”, comenta aún Francisco, está presente “ese abrazo de luz y calor” que lo reconforta: “Veré al Redentor, con estos ojos lo veré”. “Mis ojos lo verán, y no otro”. Esa certeza, en el momento finito, casi terminado de la vida “es la esperanza cristiana”. La esperanza es un don de Dios que “debemos pedir”: “Señor dame la esperanza”

Un ancla en el más allá

Francisco reflexionó también sobre las tantas cosas feas que nos llevan a la desesperación hasta creer que “todo será una derrota final, que después de la muerte no habrá nada”. En esos momentos “vuelve la voz de Job:” “sé que mi Redentor está vivo y que, en el final, se levantará sobre el polvo y lo veré, yo mismo, con estos ojos”.

El Papa recordó también que la esperanza, como dijo Pablo “no defrauda”: ella “nos atrae y da un sentido a nuestra vida”.

Yo no veo el más allá. Pero la esperanza es el don de Dios que nos atrae hacia la vida, hacia la alegría eterna. La esperanza es un ancla que tenemos del otro lado: nosotros, aferrándonos a la cuerda, nos sujetamos. “Sé que mi Redentor está vivo y lo veré”: repetir esto en los momentos de alegría y en los malos momentos, en los

momentos “de muerte”, por decirlo así. (...)El Señor nos recibe allí, donde está el ancla. La vida en la esperanza es vivir así: aferrándose, con la cuerda en la mano, fuerte, sabiendo que el ancla está ahí. Y esta ancla no decepciona: no defrauda.

Y porque “nunca podremos tener la esperanza con nuestras propias fuerzas”, “debemos pedirla”, reiteró el Papa, puesto que es “un don gratuito que nunca merecemos: es dada, es donada. Es gracia”. Es el mismo Señor quien “confirma esto”, afirmó Francisco, recordando Sus palabras: “Todo aquel que me da el Padre viene hacia mí, y al que viene a mí yo no lo echaré fuera, porque he bajado del cielo, no para hacer mi voluntad, sino la voluntad del que me envió”.
