### THIRTY FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

## November 21, 2021



This week's summary of the Preparatory Document for the 2023 Synod looks at the chapter entitled: Synodality in Action: Pathways for Consulting the People of God. It begins with these words: "Enlightened by the Word and grounded in Tradition, the synodal path is rooted in the concrete life of the People of God." In the people's journey together there is a synodality, a

listening to one another that takes place, that in and of itself makes the church more Synodal. I guess you could say that it is a work in progress. This process of conversion unfolds as the Church prays, reflects, and shares at different levels and with different degrees of intensity, incorporating the strengths and achievements as well as the limitations and difficulties of the community. It includes "the experiences activated by the present synodal journey and those in which forms of 'journeying together' are already being experienced in ordinary life, even if the term synodality is not known or used."

Next, the document considers the fundamental question that guides the consultation of the People of God: A synodal Church, in announcing the Gospel, "journeys together." How is this "journeying together" happening today in your particular Church? What steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow in our "journey together"? I continue to be amazed at how much this resonates with what we are striving to discern as a parish. There are many ways we are "journeying together," not least of which is the process that has led to our parish planning day. It is there that we hope to hear the Spirit's invitation into our next steps as a faith community.

Going deeper, the document asks us to reflect on what joys have we experienced in this process. One such joy for me is seeing the efforts unfold to serve the members of our church who are in their 20's, 30's and 40's. Then the question is posed about what difficulties and obstacles have we encountered. My response here would be the challenge of encouraging folks to participate more fully in the process and the challenge of getting people to think from a parish wide perspective and not from individual silos. The next question is to talk about what wounds has the process brought to light. Here I would say the wounds caused by us in Church leadership when we lack sensitivity to people's life situations or when we have not modeled Christ for them. Other wounds are caused by gossip, jealousy, and pettiness when that rears its ugly head in the Church. Finally, the question is posed about what insights has our experienced elicited. Again, for me it would be the importance of making sure we really listen and striving to create an environment where every single person is heard and seen.

I invite you, dear readers, to reflect on these questions from your own personal perspective. Ultimately, we come to the task of determining where the voice of the Spirit resounds and what the Spirit is asking of us. What is consistently confirmed in our dialogue with one another, what are our prospects for change, what steps do we take and where do we register consensus, and what path is opening up for us as a Church. One could say that these questions really form the task for our Planning Day.

There are different articulations of Synodality. The first is the everyday life of the Church such as unfolds here at the parish. The second is the structures and processes in which the canonical and theological synodal nature of Church is expressed in an institutional way at the local, regional, and universal levels, such as the Conference of Bishops. The third is the synodal processes and events in which the Church is convoked by the competent authority according to specific procedures determined by the ecclesiastical discipline, such as the Synod in 2023. Although these three ways are distinct, they must be held together in a coherent way so that they do not work against one another and undermine the credibility of the Church. Without this interplay the style of synodality is reduced to rhetoric and its processes and events become empty formalities. Furthermore, "journeying together" should be understood from two interconnected perspectives. The first perspective is the internal relationships of the Church – the pastors and the Faithful and the communities into which they are divided, various forms of monastic, religious and consecrated life, schools, hospitals, charitable organizations and all the other entities that make up the life extending even to the relationships and common initiatives with the brothers and sisters of other Christian denominations with whom we share the gift of the same Baptism. The second perspective considers how the People of God journeys together with the entire human family.

I will conclude this summary next week with the ten thematic nuclei to be explored on the Synodal path of communion, participation, and mission. Stay Tuned! Father George

Each year we have had a generous and warm response to the poor and struggling in our community, and throughout our Diocese.
