As we conclude the Christmas season with the Baptism of the Lord, I find myself thinking that it all went so very fast! It was kind of like being on the Polar Express! Of course, it was all very beautiful, thanks to the countless number of parishioners who invested so much of themselves to make it all happen! I smile when I reflect on the way we had what I am calling a 24-hour celebration of the birth of our Lord. It all began at 1:30 in the afternoon on Christmas eve with two of our fourteen Christmas Masses and wrapped up on Christmas day with turning off the lights in the Church at 1:30 after the 12 Noon. Just imagine how many musicians and liturgical ministers and liturgical planners and decorators and meeters and greeters and seaters and camera operators and servers it took to serve our community and provide a wonderful worship experience for all who came to adore the newborn King! You guessed it – a great number, some of who helped at multiple liturgies, including, of course, our celebrants! I am incredibly grateful to you all for your profound stewardship during these holy days. Thank you also to all who prayerfully participated in our celebrations both on site in our lower and upper churches, and the great number of folks who joined us remotely as church at home. The generosity that accompanied your presence, both to our parish and to those who we helped with our Christmas outreach, I most gratefully acknowledge.

For me personally, Christmas had a different feeling than in years past. I was more aware than ever of the true meaning of the Nativity and Epiphany of our Lord Jesus Christ, a meaning that is only found in silent solidarity with all who long for the light and love that God births in us in Jesus and that we in turn must birth for others. I am sure that this comes at least in part from my studies with the Living School and the wonderful authors we are reading, one of whom is Howard Thurman. I feel a true resonance with his striving to find the genuine that is within each of us and which defines our life purpose. I share with you this prayer poem by the Reverend Thurman as a closing to this holy season.

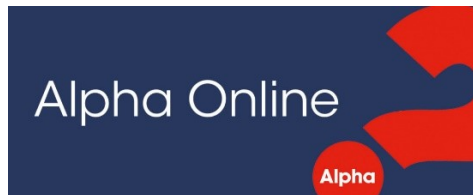


ATTENTION: MEN OF THE PARISH

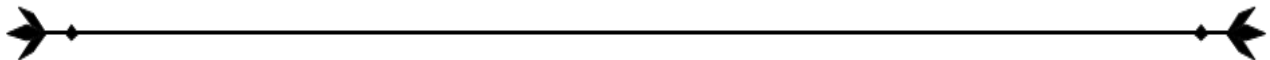

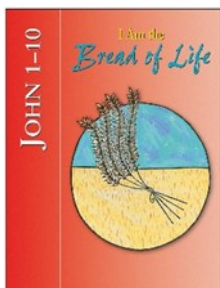

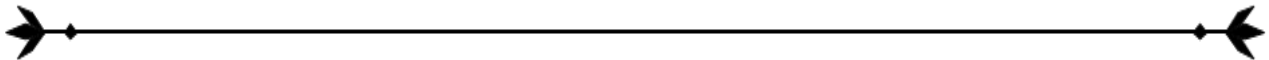
Knights of Columbus and 17 Trips Home for Active Duty Military

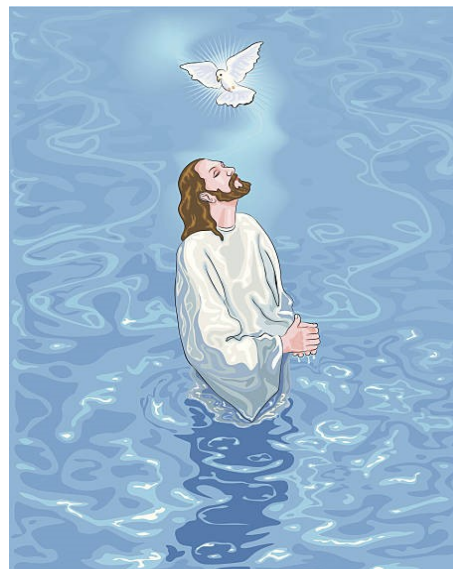
