Adult Confirmation Classes



St. Vincent is now offering an adult Confirmation process for any interested baptized Catholic. Generally, this formation process will involve instruction and faith sharing sessions during July and August via Zoom and leading up to Confirmation in late October of this year.

The focus of the program is to connect the practice of our Catholic Faith to our experiences in our everyday lives. For many who participate in this program, it is an opportunity to see, for the first time, the faith of the Church with an adult understanding. The resources are varied and many and they include a scripture study of the Gospels, The US Catholic Catechism for Adults, the Bible and some of the Vatican II documents. Participants will look at how their image of God affects the way they are in relationship with Him and spend significant time connecting daily life with the underlying meaning of Incarnation and Eucharist.

WHAT THE EUCHARIST MEANS TO ME BY ALBERTA WALSH

For most of my adult life, receiving Holy Communion meant taking Jesus in, accepting His presence into my being and very soul. All of which are necessary and lead to sanctifying grace. However, as my faith has matured, I've come to believe that just as I receive Jesus when partaking of the host, He, at the same time, is receiving me into His Presence, embracing me in His love. This blessed exchange between Jesus and I is "Our Communion With The Lord". Eucharist means Thanksgiving; there is nothing that I am more thankful for, than my union with Jesus.

A Holy Hour of Adoration is another way to experience this exchange of love and unity with Our Lord. I find that sitting before Jesus in the monstrance is the most peaceful place on earth. I envision myself in His embrace. I pour out my heart to Him and He always gives me something. At times it may be strength or a new insight sometimes tears which provide release, sometimes only an escape from the noise of life. No matter what, time with Jesus is time well spent.

Stewardship

This week is a reminder of our call for total dedication to God and to Jesus' mission which, as Paul reminds us, is to love our neighbors as we love ourselves. However, this idea of putting others before ourselves is disarming, and even off-putting. We are inclined to ask, "What's in it for me?" This is natural, and as some would argue, a matter of survival. We want to cling to what we know and stay grounded in the material world. But Jesus wants us to go beyond mere survival and calls us to something much more. He calls us to put ourselves second and to be of service to others. This is how we are to bear fruit in the world: to go against what the world expects and wants of us. Instead of wanting what the world wants for us, we should want what God wants for us. In the end, and as stewards of Jesus' mission, we are called to be different. So, with great joy, let us embrace this calling to go to wherever He calls us, no matter how vulnerable or out of our element we may feel. He is with us and will guide us. Jesus, I trust in you.




