




The Parish office will be closed Monday, July 4 in observance of Independence Day.

Adult Confirmation Classes



St. Vincent is now offering an adult Confirmation process for any interested baptized Catholic. Generally, this formation process will involve instruction and faith sharing sessions during July and August via Zoom and leading up to Confirmation in late October of this year.

The focus of the program is to connect the practice of our Catholic Faith to our experiences in our everyday lives. For many who participate in this program, it is an opportunity to see, for the first time, the faith of the Church with an adult understanding. The resources are varied and many and they include a scripture study of the Gospels, The US Catholic Catechism for Adults, the Bible and some of the Vatican II documents. Participants will look at how their image of God affects the way they are in relationship with Him and spend significant time connecting daily life with the underlying meaning of Incarnation and Eucharist.

WHAT THE EUCHARIST MEANS TO ME BY LIZ VACCHIANO

What Eucharist means to me is being with my best friend Jesus, whether at Holy Hour or Mass. At Sunday Mass, I prepare myself through the readings, homily and prayers that lead us to the liturgy of the Eucharist. During the liturgy of the Eucharist, I intently focus on the words of Jesus that the Priest prays over the bread and wine. I remember and make present Jesus' sacrifice on the Cross for my salvation. I think of Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane, praying for his Father to take this cup from Him – if this is His Father's will. I think of all the lies, betrayal and ultimately death that Christ suffered for me – for us – so we can have a place in Heaven. After receiving Jesus, He and I become one. I pray that when I am sent forth at the end of Mass, that I stay in communion with Christ and any suffering that I encounter during the week I can pray about and offer to Jesus to participate in His saving works.

As Jesus sends his disciples out in pairs to do His work, so, too, we are called to be His disciples and stewards. He knows they will be welcomed by some and rejected by others. We are called to evangelize and to be disciples of His word even when we are met with resistance and skepticism! It is during those times that we are truly tested. We continue our work knowing that we will be guided and strengthened with the grace He will provide to us.

When the disciples joyfully returned, they knew they had completed their mission. Having been given the power from Jesus to tread upon the "full force of the enemy". He reminds them not to rejoice for having the power over this evil, but rather rejoice because of their FAITH and good work they now have earned a place in heaven.

We must continue our discipleship looking forward to that same reward.


