This past Tuesday evening our Finance Council, Pastoral Council, Stewardship Council and Parish Staff were given a wonderful presentation on the results of our work of gathering input for the Synod on Synodality that will be taking place in Rome in October 2023. We were given information on both our parish findings, and those of the Diocese of Paterson. I am grateful to Matt Bradford who did the lion's share of the work in processing the information, and to Sandra Liscari and Jan Figenshu who assisted in this effort. I invite you to mark your calendars for Sunday, October 30 at 3PM when we will gather the whole parish community to listen to the report on our synodal involvement and to report on the progress that is being made with our five new priority areas for Saint Vincent Martyr: Connect, Resource, Disciple, Outreach and Emerge. In this bulletin article and in the four that will follow I will expand on each of these areas, sharing a few of my own thoughts and insights on their importance in the life of the parish. As you know, the priority areas themselves were developed in a synodal fashion, incorporating deep listening, lively discussion, and consensus building. Let's begin with CONNECT.

Our Pastoral Council offers this description of CONNECT: *St. Vincent Martyr Parish, a Eucharistic Community, welcomes its members to develop and grow both social and spiritual connections, in order to foster a sense of belonging and shared purpose among the varied and diverse groups of our parish.*

I begin by underlining the word "Eucharistic." We know that as Catholics we find our identity in the Eucharist. St. Augustine reminds us that we, the Church, become what we receive. Thus, we become the living Body of Christ in the world. St Paul tells us that the body, though one, has many parts, each needing the other. Thus, we are connected in Christ! This connection is essential to being the community of faith that a parish is called to be. As you know, we relate to one another both socially and spiritually. Through our stewardship effort we want to reinforce those aspects of parish life that foster connections, and to create new opportunities for connecting spiritually and socially where that is needed. An example of this would be the evening for our Senior parishioners that we will enjoy at the end of October. We listened and heard that our Seniors were looking for this outreach and we put in motion something to make it happen.

The goal of growing connectivity here at SVM is to foster a strong sense of belonging, which is a fundamental need of the human person, and necessary for a person to become his or her best version of self. Having a deep sense of belonging to a community serves to deepen one's understanding of what it means to belong to God. We also want to foster a shared purpose for our life here at the parish, which is fundamentally to build up the reign of God in the world by sharing the love of Jesus Christ. This unified vision of our work as disciples and Church offers the context in which we can understand our diversity and learn to work together for the good of all. And so, we seek to connect the varied groups of our parish, each enriching the other and together creating a stronger and better force for good and grace in the world. A purpose driven church is a church that understands what it means to be gifted, grateful, giving and growing.

Another way of putting the above is, as Richard Rohr states: the way you do anything is the way you do everything. And putting that into the context of today's Gospel we have to ask: what is our relationship to our possessions? Are we squanderers? accumulators? Or are we actual caretakers of all that we have been *freely* given by God?

In the end, it is incumbent upon and *expected* of us that we will bear fruit, for God, with all that He has given us. And so we must reframe our view and instead of patting ourselves on our backs we must, instead, be humble to God for what He has *bestowed upon* us. This reframe will garner a true appreciation for all that we have. This appreciation to God will then dictate all that we do. The focus will shift from how we can get more, to how we can help others and always be at the ready and listening for what God needs us to do, before then acting. Our goal should be to become trustworthy stewards where everything we do is in service of and in thanks to God.

Year of the Eucharist

PRIEST'S VESTMENTS DURING MASS

Every priest uses the same vestments during each Mass. There can be different colors as there are different solemnities and different liturgical seasons throughout the year. Every vestment has a deep meaning and symbol:

Amice – defends against the temptations of the devil and symbolizes the moderation of the words.

Alb – white or crème, symbolizes the purity in which the priest lives and brings it to the altar.

Cincture (matches the color of the stole and chasuble) – as Jesus said, "gird your loins", it symbolizes purity and belonging to Jesus.

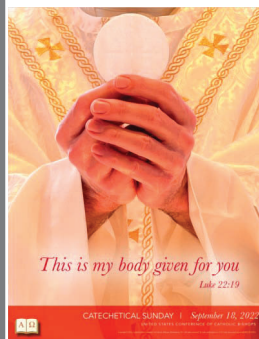
Stole (the color is always the same as the chasuble) symbolizes priestly power and authority.

Chasuble – worn above all other vestments, symbolizes charity.

Colors of vestments vary depending on the Liturgical Season or the type of Mass being celebrated. To be continued ...

This year, the Church will celebrate Catechetical Sunday on September 18, 2022 under the theme of "This is my body given for you." On this day, catechists are formally commissioned for ministry to the community. Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role that each baptized person plays in handing on the faith and being a witness to the Gospel. Catechetical Sunday is an opportunity for all to rededicate themselves to this mission as a community of faith.

The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. The term "Eucharist" originates from the Greek word eucharistia, meaning thanksgiving. In the celebration of the Eucharist, bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit and the instrumentality of the priest. The whole Christ is truly present -- body, blood, soul, and divinity -- under the appearances of bread and wine, the glorified Christ who rose from the dead. This is what the Church means when she speaks of the "Real Presence" of Christ in the Eucharist.
