Dear Friends,

Today we celebrate the *Divine Mercy Sunday*, the day when we are reminded about the ultimate truth that God is and has been from the very beginning the same, Love and Mercy Itself. He fully revealed this in the life of Jesus whose miracles, death and resurrection were done out of love and mercy for the suffering ones and for the sinners. We need to obtain divine mercy and pray for it, because we are not perfect and we sometimes commit a sin which upsets our Lord. God chose many saints to remind us of his love and mercy for his children. One of them was a *secretary* of Divine Mercy, St. Faustina Kowalska.

St. Faustina was born on August 25, 1905 as Helena Kowalska, in Glogowiec, in central Poland. Faustina first felt a calling to the religious life when she was just seven-years-old. At the age of 19, in spite of many difficulties, she was admitted to the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy in Warsaw. On February 22, 1931, Faustina was visited by Jesus, who presented himself as the "King of Divine Mercy" wearing a white garment with red and pale rays coming from his heart, symbols of baptism and Eucharist. She was asked to become the instrument for giving the world God's love and mercy. Jesus also asked St. Faustina to *paint an image of me according to the pattern you see, with the inscription: Jesus, I trust in You*. Our Lord also asked the picture to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter and also to *name this Sunday the Feast of Mercy*. In 1933 in Vilnius, Lithuania, Faustina met Father Michael Sopocko, her future confessor and an artist, Eugene Kazimierowski, who painted the first Divine Mercy image. In September 1935, Faustina wrote about her vision of the *Chaplet of Divine Mercy*, used to obtain mercy, trust in Christ's mercy and to show mercy to others. In 1937 the Divine Mercy images and prayer cards were created and the message started to spread. By the end of this year Faustina's health failed, her visions intensified and she said she was ready to go home to the Lord. On October 5, 1938, Faustina passed away. Her body rests at the Basilica of Divine Mercy in Krakow, Poland.

St. Faustina's entire life, in imitation of Christ's, was to be love and mercy for others. She did this by prayer, example of life and physical work. She also willingly offered her personal sufferings in union with Jesus to atone for the sins of others.

We can also promote God's mercy by following a simple *ABC rule* - **A** - Ask for His Mercy, **B** - Be merciful. **C** - Completely trust in Jesus who loves you boundlessly. Also, on the 2nd Easter Sunday we will have a Divine Mercy service, beginning with confessions at 2.15 pm and Divine Mercy Holy Hour at 3 pm. Please join us in prayer for mercy and peace for the world. Let us, friends, always trust in Jesus!

How to pray Divine Mercy Chaplet?

This prayer was given to St. Faustina by our Lord Jesus Himself. We pray it on the rosary beads. After making the sign of the cross, pray: *O Blood and Water which gushed forth from the heart of Jesus as a fountain of mercy for us, I trust in you!* (three times). Then *Our Father, Hail Mary and The Apostles' Creed* prayers. Next, on Our Father's beads, we pray: *Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your dearly beloved Son our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world*. Then on the Hail Mary beads: *For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world*. After five decades, we conclude praying: *Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world* (three times).

As *optional prayers* we can pray at the beginning: *You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us*. And at the end: *Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless, and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look upon us, and increase your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to our Holy Will, which is Love and Mercy itself. Amen.*

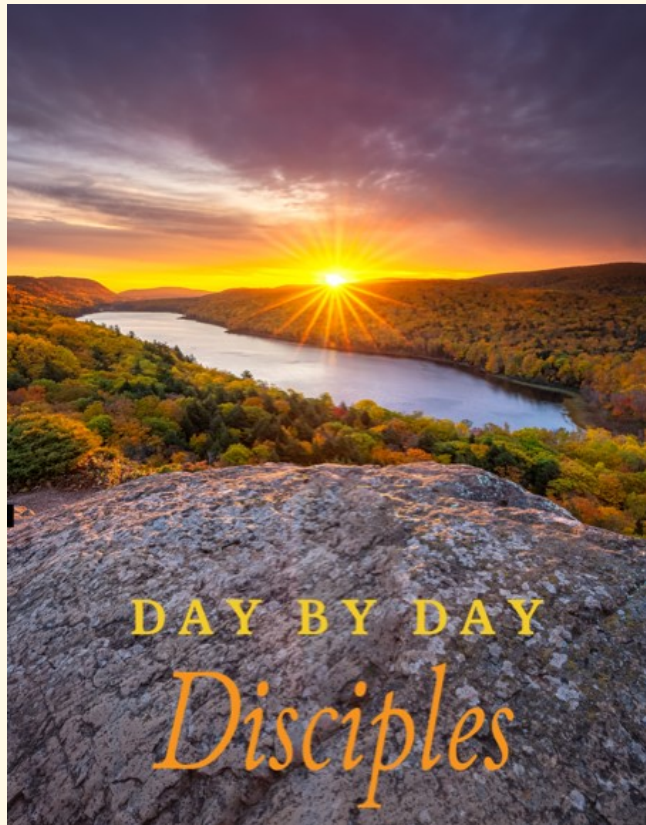

"UNLESS I SEE...I WILL NOT BELIEVE"

We can all relate to Thomas' doubt. We do not want to be taken advantage of or seem foolish, and so we will need to see the evidence. Touch it. Feel it. Make sense of it. Performing our due diligence can provide us with the confidence we need to pull the trigger on a decision. Yet at the same time, having information, whether a lot or a little, is not a guarantee of success. At some point, we still need to have faith and go with it. If in the end it comes down to having *faith* in our decision, then we should look to take Jesus up on His invitation to just believe. After all, He is the Way, the Truth and the Light. On this Divine Mercy Sunday, we should take some time to think about our Thomas moments. In so doing, we should take pause, give thanks to Jesus and God for being with us, and ask them for their help and mercy. We should put our faith in them that they will see us through, instead of looking for evidence and certainty. And it is when we start viewing the world through Jesus' eyes - eyes of faith - then we will truly see.

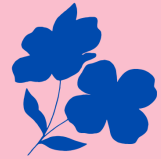


CHOIR CONCERT

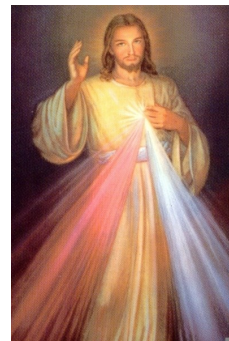



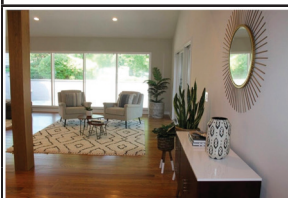
