**Alleluia, Alleluia, Give thanks to the Risen Lord! Alleluia, Alleluia, sing praise to His Name!**

Looking back on our celebration of Holy Week and Easter, the words 'thanks' and 'praise' most definitely express what my heart is feeling. I am deeply grateful for all the men and women, boys and girls, who stepped forward to create a beautiful experience of worship for all who came to pray with us during those sacred days. Let me underline the word 'beautiful', for that is the description of our liturgies that I am hearing most often during these days. Beauty draws us to God, who is all beauty – when we experience beauty here on earth, we get a glimpse of the beatific vision we hope to enjoy in heaven. I believe we enjoyed a bit of heaven here at Saint Vincent Martyr during those days we gathered as Church to remember the Passion, Death and Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ.

It was heavenly for me to have the privilege of baptizing the biggest number of catechumen at one time in all my years of priesthood. We brought seven – the biblical number of perfection and completeness – into the Church at our Vigil. Congratulations to Suzanne, Jacob, Thomas, William, Elaine, Patrick and Eric on receiving the Easter sacraments. I also congratulate Andras who was received into the Catholic Church and confirmed in the faith along with Darby, Louis and Xavier. A huge thank you to Jan Figenshu and her RCIA team for accompanying these brothers and sisters in Christ on their journey of faith. I can't think of any better guides to the road to heaven!

The sounds of praise that came forth from our music ministry were nothing less than heavenly. With angelic voices and symphonic sounds from keyboards, bells, flutes, and stringed instruments directed and blended together by our music minister Peter we were lifted up as we gave glory to God for all God has done for us in Jesus Christ. Our musical journey through those days deepened our awareness of each event, from the Hosannas that started the week, the tunes of gathering that brought us to the table, the mournful tones that marked Christ's death and finally to the canticles of hope and new life that celebrated Christ's rising from the dead. We were certainly sung into Easter!

The ranks of heavenly hosts were also present in full array in those days - the Welcomers, who under the dedicated leadership of Valerie, paved the way with hospitality, warmth and kindness into our parish for all who came to worship, helping them find their place of belonging; the Readers who proclaimed the Word of God with reverence and devotion, helping us feast at the table of the Word; our Ministers of Communion who distributed the precious gift of Eucharist with such love and care; our littlest angels who served God's altar so attentively and rose to the extra liturgical challenges of the celebrations; those who decorated the halls of the heavenly banquet, our diligent director of Liturgy Jan and those who planned our liturgies and scheduled our ministers, our Sacristan Val who made sure that all was ready for worship, our facilities guys Randall and Tommy in their ministry of moving and climbing and lugging, our wonderful office staff and pastoral staff that brought their own gifts to the work of the season and of course Fr. Chris, Deacon Bob and Carlos – three archangels around the heavenly throne.

Finally, heaven would not be complete without all of you who make Saint Vincent come alive with your prayers, your presence, and your generosity to the parish and to those who are in need! A heartfelt, happy, hallelujah, honey from the rock, holy, hymn singing thank you to you all. Have a blessed Easter season filled with the joy and peace of our Risen Savior!

### *From Father George*

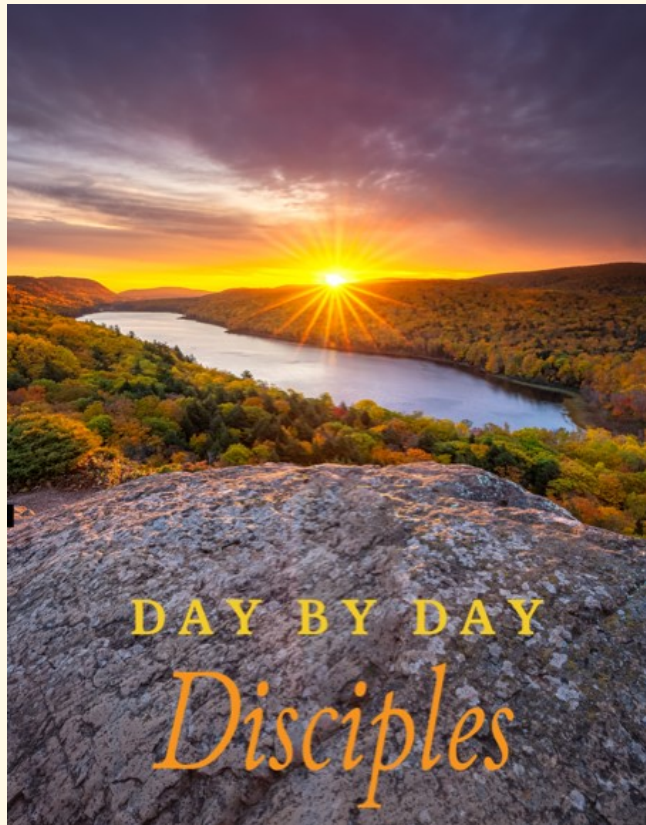
