Thank you for all the love and support that you are showing me in entering this time of bringing to a close my pastorate here at Saint Vincent Martyr and preparing to take on the pastoral leadership of Saint Gerard Majella in Paterson. In a way it is like going full circle, returning to the church where I first was pastor. On the other hand, they are a very different church today than in 1995, and I am a very different priest. Back then I was just forty years old, young, and couldn't wait to be king! Now I am nearing seventy and hopefully wise enough to know that it is God, not me, who is in charge. So we will see where He takes us!

It was during my pastorate at Saint Gerard Majella that my mother Rose went home to the Lord. Mom and I had a tradition that for Mother's Day, instead of me trying to buy her something, we would go out to lunch and enjoy one another's company. I think we came up with this idea after the time that I bought her an article of clothing that was three times her size — not a good move! And so it happened that when Mother's Day in 1997 came about I called mom to make our luncheon date. I still remember that she said to me that I was so busy and that maybe it would be better to put it off until I had more time. By the grace of God, I said no to that proposal and we set the date for our mother/son lunch. Thanks be to God, for only two weeks after we went out together my dear mother contracted a fatal infection that took her from us quickly and unexpectedly. I could have received no better life lesson than to never be "too busy" that we don't make time for those we love.

I will never forget the outpouring of love I experienced from the community of Saint Gerard at her passing and from her home parish of Our Lady of the Valley in Wayne. I was to experience that again and again from you, my beloved family here at Saint Vincent Martyr at the death first of my sister, and then my dad. When my mom died there were so many generous contributions that we were able to purchase a beautiful nativity set for the parish that is still used to this day. The parish itself made a beautiful gesture in memory of my mother, restoring the bells that had gone silent years before. When you visit me at St. Gerard's you will see the plaque in the prayer garden memorializing that gift. You'll hear the bells also as they ring out in praise of God.

You have heard me quote that verse from Rodgers and Hammerstein's Sound of Music – a bell's not a bell till you ring it, a song's not a song till you sing it, love in your heart wasn't put there to stay, love isn't love till you give it away. I am grateful for all the ways my mom rang out her love for me, being my biggest cheerleader and greatest fan. And while she does that now from heaven, I continue to receive that unconditional love from my mom on this side of life, Nina. Adding to that love and creating a joyful peal is the care and support I get from my sister Mary and from those wonderful women who are friends and parishioners who nurture me and lift me up! I am truly blessed!

I realize that not every person is as fortunate as I to have such a beautiful experience of living in the flow of God's love so wonderfully incarnated in the love of a mother. Our Blessed Mother knows your pain and lifts you up to her Son Jesus for your healing and peace. In her mantle we all find a place of gratitude to God whose love resounds in our lives and never is silenced. Let us give thanks to God for our moms, living and deceased, in whatever way they claim that name, and wish them all a happy and blessed Mother's Day! God bless.


