


Revival's in the air! There is an exciting journey ahead! We all know that our world is hurting. We all need healing, yet many of us are separated from the very source of our strength. Jesus Christ invites us to the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is a movement to restore understanding and devotion to this great mystery here

in the United States by helping us renew our worship of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

The United States Catholic Conference of Bishops has launched this revival now because the Church needs healing, and the world needs the Church. The Church has withstood scandal, division, disease and doubt throughout our very human history. But today we confront all of them, all at once. Our response in this moment is pivotal. In the midst of these roaring waves, Jesus is present, reminding us that He is more powerful than the storm. He desires to heal, renew, and unify the Church and the world. How will He do it? By uniting us once again around the source and summit of our faith in the celebration of the Eucharist. The National Eucharistic Revival is the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. to this divine invitation.

It takes time to kindle a living, loving relationship – and a relationship with Jesus Christ is no exception. That's why the Eucharistic Revival has allowed three years for discernment, encounter, and grassroots response on the diocesan, parish and individual levels. The Revival actually began last year on June 19, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi. You may recall that here at the parish we had a beautiful celebration that included a bilingual Mass, a Eucharistic Procession, a supper, and Adoration. Before and after that weekend, our Eucharistic missionaries with the guidance of Fr. Chris fostered activities connected with our Diocesan Year of the Eucharist.

With the celebration of the Solemnity this weekend we begin the second year of the Revival the focus of which is to foster Eucharistic devotion at the parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, missions, resources, preaching and organic movements of the Holy Spirit. These initiatives will be overseen by our parish Liturgy Committee, chaired by Jan.

The culmination of this second year will be the National Eucharistic Congress which will take place in Indianapolis, Indiana on July 17 – 24, 2024. At this historic event, more than 80,000 Catholics of all ages will gather in Indianapolis to reconsecrate their hearts to the source and summit of our faith.

The third year of the Eucharistic Revival is the Year of Going Out on Mission, beginning on the last day of the Congress and extending through Pentecost, 2025. Having enkindled a missionary fire in the hearts of the American faithful, the Holy Spirit will send us out on mission to share the gift of our Eucharistic Lord as we enter the universal Church's Jubilee year in 2025.

Bishop Sweeney will mark the beginning of the second year of the Eucharistic Revival by gathering the faithful of the diocese on Sunday evening June 11 at Corpus Christi parish in Chatham Township for Adoration, Praise and Worship and Benediction to enhance our understanding of, love for, and living out of the Holy Eucharist. Bishop will be joined by Fr. Agustino Torres, CFR, who is one of the National Eucharistic preachers. You are very welcome to join in this beautiful celebration.

It makes my heart glad knowing that I will remain united with you in Christ through the Eucharist for this entire journey of revival, even though I am going to a new assignment. That is the beauty of this awesome Blessed Sacrament – it makes us one with the Lord, and through Him with one another, wherever we may be. God bless!

The following is a prayer composed by Bishop Andrew Cozzens, chairman of the Committee on Evangelization and Catechesis, for this second phase of Eucharistic Revival.

Lord Jesus Christ, you give us your flesh and blood for the life of the world, and you desire that all people come to the Supper of the Lamb. Renew in your Church the truth, beauty and goodness contained in the Most Blessed Eucharist Sacrifice.

Jesus living in the Eucharist, come and live in me.

Jesus healing in the Eucharist, come and heal me.

Jesus sacrificing yourself in the Eucharist, come and suffer in me.

Jesus rising in the Eucharist, come and rise to new life in me.

Jesus loving in the Eucharist, come and love in me.

Lord Jesus Christ, through the paschal mystery of your death and resurrection made present in every Holy Mass, pour out your healing love on your Church and on our world. Grant that as we lift you up during this time of Eucharistic Revival, your Holy Spirit may draw all people to join us at the Banquet of Life. You live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, God forever and ever.

Our Lady of Guadalupe, Mother of the Eucharist, Pray for us.

Adult Confirmation Classes



St. Vincent is now offering an adult Confirmation process for any interested baptized Catholic. Generally, this formation process will involve instruction and faith sharing sessions during July and August via Zoom and leading up to Confirmation in the Fall of this year. The focus of the program is to connect the practice of our Catholic Faith to our experiences in our everyday lives. For many who participate in this program, it is an opportunity to see, for the first time, the faith of the Church with an adult

understanding. The resources are varied and many and they include a scripture study of the Gospels, The US Catholic Catechism for Adults, the Bible and some of the Vatican II documents. Participants will look at how their image of God affects the way they are in relationship with Him and spend significant time connecting daily life with the underlying meaning of incarnation and Eucharist.

"EAT MY FLESH AND DRINK MY BLOOD"

It is a monumental day today, since we are once again offered the Cup at Mass. We haven't had this opportunity in our parish since Covid began. As we step up to partake in Holy Communion, we must become one with Him, one body in Christ; we must remain in Him and Him in us. "This is the bread that came down from heaven... whoever eats this bread will live forever." Participation in the sacrament of the Eucharist requires more than just going through the motions. Pope John Paul II stated in a sermon he gave on Corpus Christi: "In order to live we need food and drink. In order to gain eternal life, we need the Eucharist. This is the food and drink that transforms our lives and opens before us the way to eternal life. By consuming the Body and Blood of Christ, we bear within ourselves already on this earth, the seed of eternal life, for the Eucharist is the sacrament of life in God." As we are transformed by the Eucharist, let us transform into becoming better stewards and sharing our gifts with one another and become One Body in Christ.


