In my room at the rectory, I have a photo of my dad and me taken on the day he married my stepmother, Nina. Talk about a couple of handsome guys. Right next to the photo is a card that reads: There is an incredible satisfaction and there are feelings of pure pride and joy when you get to see your own kid become wonderful, confident, caring people. You'd like to think you might have had a little something to do with it...but really you know that really, it's just one more gracious gift from our faithful and loving Heavenly Father. You're doing a great job son, and today we're celebrating you, the wonderful you God made, and all the ways God is working through you.

The card is not signed because my dad purchased it months before my birthday – we found it among his effects after he died. I see it as a message that he left for me, his last words to me. I hold these words in my heart as we never had the chance to say goodbye to each other, as his passing was sudden and unanticipated. In truth, dad and I never spoke about how we felt about each other. It would always amaze me how my brother and sister could spend an hour on the phone with him. Our conversations were always so brief. But we didn't need a lot of words. We had a bond with each other that we both understood. We shouldered the challenges of life together and quietly delighted in each other's moment of happiness and success. In the end I knew that I was his beloved son, and he, my much loved father.

On my dad's remembrance card is a picture of our Saint Joseph window in the vesting sacristy of our church. We chose that because my father had a great devotion to Saint Joseph and prayed every day to the great saint. Dad was very much like Saint Joseph – the quiet presence in the life of the family, providing what was needed in the moment, sacrificing his own needs to take care of others. I like to think that I have become my dad – definitely not in political viewpoints and perspectives – but more importantly in being a man of deep compassion who desires to do good for the other, to seek their good, which ultimately means to love them with the love of Christ.

I know that my dad is praying for me as I get ready to make this transition in my life. I want him to know that he has indeed had much to do with the man I have become today, open to the will of God and ready to serve Him in whatever way He needs me. I am grateful for my father who I think of every day, especially when I make my prayer in front of the statue of the Good Shepherd on the side of our Church. I am so glad that we dedicated that beautiful work of art to my dad, for he was a beautiful work of God, a shepherd of our family in so many ways!

I pray for all our dads in the parish and all those men who show a fatherly love to family and to friends. May God enlighten the eyes of your heart to see that you truly are beloved sons of God, beautifully made in His image, called to serve with a shepherd's heart and appreciated for all that you do! May God bless each of you with happiness and good health, with peace and good fortune. And may the Lord grant eternal rest and peace to our dads who have gone home to heaven. Happy Father's Day! 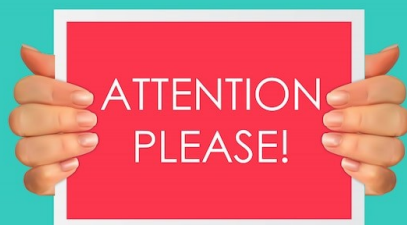

Adult Confirmation Classes



St. Vincent is now offering an adult Confirmation process for any interested baptized Catholic. Generally, this formation process will involve instruction and faith sharing sessions during July and August via Zoom and leading up to Confirmation in the Fall of this year. The focus of the program is to connect the practice of our Catholic Faith to our experiences in our everyday lives. For many who participate in this program, it is an opportunity to see, for the first time, the faith of the Church with an adult understanding. The resources are varied and many and they include a scripture study of the Gospels, The US Catholic Catechism for Adults, the Bible and some of the Vatican II documents. Participants will look at how their image of God affects the way they are in relationship with Him and spend significant time connecting daily life with the underlying meaning of incarnation and Eucharist.

"THE HARVEST IS ABUNDANT BUT THE LABORERS FEW"

Jesus summoned His twelve disciples to send them out to call back the lost sheep of Israel in this week's reading. It is easy for us to think of what we read in the Bible as specific to its era and its audience. However, this call is not frozen in time and was not just for the twelve. Instead, it is a call that echoes through the ages. It is eternal. It is the call that He bestows upon us when we are baptized. As God says to Moses, we are "a kingdom of priests." We are set apart to model our lives after the ultimate model, Jesus, and to call back all of God's lost children.

As God's chosen, everything we have is from Him to accomplish this mission. He has freely given us our talents and gifts and expects us to use *all* that He has given us in service of this mission. For when we pour ourselves out in service of others, we are pouring out God's abundant love into the world.

Three years ago, St Vincent Martyr was honored to kick off the first week of the new Motel Shelter Program at Family Promise of Morris County, providing emergency shelter to individuals and families in need. Now the Shelter Program is in critical need of funding. A grant received through the CARES Act that has been funding the motel sheltering program will end in June. The cost of one night of shelter at the Extended Stay Motel is \$80 per room. We have been utilizing three rooms, which brings the amount to \$240 per night. There are about 214 households on the shelter waiting list hoping to enter a shelter program. 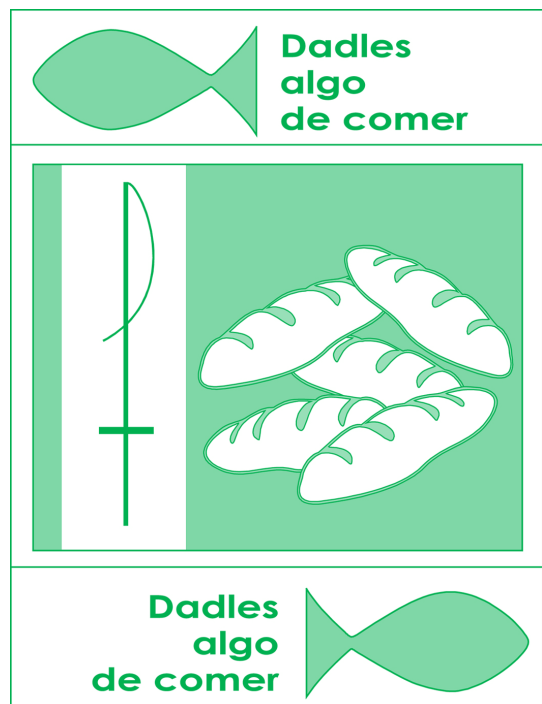
