Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



To the two beautiful parish families of Saint Vincent Martyr in Madison and Saint Gerard Majella in Paterson.

Allow me to introduce you to one another. Saint Vincent Martyr is the older of you both, having been established as a parish in 1825, after being a mission of Saint Peter's Church in New York City. Saint Gerard was established as a parish in 1961, formed from the mother Church of Saint Michael's in Paterson. Both of you have played an incredibly important role in my life. It was in 1995 that I made the decision to apply for the pastorate of Saint Gerard which had opened up with Monsignor Lou Bihr's move to Immaculate Heart of Mary in Wayne. I had been mentored up to that point by many fine priests - Msgr. Vince Malloy, Msgr. Kevin Flanagan, Msgr. Jake Rugel, Msgr. Jim O'Rorke and also Bishop Rodimer – all who taught me various things about being a pastor. If I had any doubt over whether I should have applied to be pastor, that doubt was quickly dispelled when Msgr. Mark Giordani, a former beloved pastor of Saint Gerard's, pulled me aside at a diocesan gathering, put his arm around my shoulder, and said to me: "Giorgio, you should go for the parish!" I still remember showing up at St. Gerard at its fundraising bazaar in my maroon Members Only jacket as the new kid on the block. And I really was a kid when it came to being a pastor. You, the parish of Saint Gerard Majella, patiently saw me through my formative years of shepherding a church and gave me a foundation in this pastoral ministry that I love so dearly. I was called away from serving you in 2002 when Bishop Rodimer asked me to take on the pastorate of Saint Anthony in Hawthorne. It was there that I honed my pastoral skills and was educated in the ins and outs of caring for a very large parish with many ministries and activities. At Saint Anthony I was able to introduce stewardship into the life of the parish and to initiate both Men and Women's Cornerstone. It was Bishop Serratelli who called in 2009 with the request that I consider taking on the leadership of Saint Vincent Martyr in Madison. Discerning that the Spirit was calling me in that direction I came to Morris County to begin a wonderful journey with you, Saint Vincent Martyr, a community eager to envision what we could be as church and ready to do the work needed to make that vision a reality. With you I experienced the power of listening, discerning and collaborating as we brought forth a pastoral plan for the parish that included growth in discipleship, the renovation of our church and the expansion of our school. It is you, the parish family of St. Vincent, that matured me in my role as pastor as I learned to live from a more contemplative stance in life, responding more authentically to the challenges of priestly ministry. And now I have been called by the Holy Spirit and Bishop Sweeney to return to where this journey of being pastor began, to leave you, my beloved church of Saint Vincent Martyr and to once again pastor you, my beloved church of Saint Gerard Majella. I return quite a bit older and a little bit wiser, grateful to the Vocationists for their outstanding pastoral care, and open to what may unfold in these elder years. I know that there is room in my heart for both of you and for all the other places I have been privileged to serve in my priesthood. Over these next three months as I minister to both of you, assisted by Fr. Manuel Cuellar, a zealous and talented young priest whose heart is afire with the love of the Lord, I will consider myself as standing on a singular expanse of holy ground extending from Madison to Paterson, the one Spirit bridging the distance. I know that you all will be patient as we effect this transition and discover the future that God has set before us all. May God sustain us in His love and bless us with his peace. Holy Mary, Mother of God and of the Church, pray for us. Saint Vincent Martyr, pray for us. Saint Gerard Majella, pray for us! God bless.


