La Bella Vita

Dear Friends,

A few weeks ago, I was blessed to go to the homeland of so many of you, to Italy. And I must say: It was a wonderful experience! Italy is a beautiful country, with good and joyful people and with so many holy places. I went there to lead a pilgrimage for 206 Tours company. First, we admired Rome. We were greatly blessed to see Pope Francis, all the major Basilicas (for me the most beautiful things in the world), Holy Stairs (on which Pilate stood sentencing Jesus to death), Appian Way (where Jesus stopped Peter who was running away in the time of persecutions) and Catacombs, a place of burial of the first Christians. I was also thrilled to meet a newly ordained priest of our diocese, Fr. Krzysztof (what a beautiful name J) Tyszko, in the North American College and my dear friends Saverio and Josephine and their family. After Rome we headed to Monte Cassino to visit St. Benedict, the founder of a monastic life and his sister St. Scholastica. Afterwards, we went to San Giovanni Rotondo to spend two days with Padre Pio. We saw his body, his cell, crucifix from which he received stigmata and the confessional where he spent hours on absolving people from their sins. I was also greatly blessed and moved to be able to bless my pilgrims with the glove which Saint Pio wore to cover his stigmata. We also attended a beautiful Candlelight Procession at 9 pm. Next, we went to Lanciano, to see the Eucharistic Miracle (on the consecrated host there is still the blood of Jesus) and to Loreto, where is the house of the Blessed Mother (tradition says the angel brought it from Israel). Next stop was Assisi. We saw St. Francis' tomb as well as the tombs of St. Claire and blessed Carlo Acutis. We prayed at the church where Jesus asked Francis to rebuild his Church. We also admired the "Porziuncola", a place where St. Francis founded Franciscan order and the "Capella del Transito" which is the place where St. Francis died. Our last day we spent in a cute little town called Gubbio where St. Francis stopped the wolf from killing people and in La Verna where the saint received stigmata. After this holy and uplifting soul pilgrimage I was happy to visit momma, family, and friends in Poland. Thanks be to God; everybody is good there. And I became an uncle for the fourth time! I'm very happy to say that my time in Italy was a tempo felice!

May Padre Pio intercede for us during our Eucharistic Revival years,


