Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



Hello my friends. I am writing to you from Albuquerque, New Mexico where I will begin my final week of studies at the Living School at the Center for Action and Contemplation later today. It is Monday morning and already the temperature is 93 degrees going up to 103! I took a walk at 6 AM along the Rio Grande River under a beautiful bright blue sky and on the way saw a couple of hummingbirds, two coyotes and an egret. The air was fresh, and the scent of the various trees and shrubs filled the air. I found myself singing in praise of God for the beauty of His creation and thanking Him for the many blessings he has bestowed upon me, not least of which is the blessing of YOU!

It was on a retreat in August of 2018 that I first really discovered the powerful presence of God in nature. Part of the retreat was a day of solitude and fasting that we spent in the woods. I became keenly aware of the beauty of what God had created. Indeed, beauty is one of the pathways to God, and the pathway of nature is one that God has set before us from the beginning of time to find our way to Him! I think of the hymn, "For the Beauty of the Earth", its lyrics instructing us in finding God in the gift of creation: "For the beauty of the earth, for the glory of the skies, for the love from which our birth over and around us lies. Lord of all to thee we raise, this is our hymn of grateful praise! For the beauty of each hour, of the day and of the night, hill and vale and tree and flower, sun and moon and stars of light. Lord of all, to Thee we raise, This our hymn of grateful praise!"

Since that retreat I have been very mindful and intentional in developing my relationship with our Creator, paying attention to the ways that He reveals himself in nature. I pay much more attention now to the morning and evening sky, to the birdsong at the beginning and the end of the day, to the majesty of mountains and the stateliness of trees, to the beauty of flowers and the fragrances they share, to the animals wild and tame who surprise us and bring us joy, to gentle cool breezes and to fierce thunderstorms with their brilliant lightning and strong winds, to flowing streams, mighty rivers, serene lakes and expansive seas and oceans – God's presence is in them all. God also reveals himself in the movement of the seasons of birth, of growth, of diminishment, of death and of new birth, and those things who surrender their life to the earth so that new life may come forth. And God is present in the crowning of creation, in you and me, his beloved, to whom he has entrusted the care of creation, the care of the earth. Truly, God is in all things and at the same time, greater than all things!

I believe that when we expand our vision of God, when we begin to see the presence of Christ in all of creation, when we recognize the movement of the Holy Spirit as a life force in creation, then we ourselves will be expanded in our living and our loving, for God is Life and God is Love. Christ truly present in the bread and wine that becomes His Body and Blood, Soul, and Divinity, calls us to see His presence in one another and all that His Father has created with the breath of the Holy Spirit. This is what Eucharistic disciples do, this is the task of the Church!

I am committed to growing in this dimension of my spirituality, to doing this necessary soul work, and to sharing its fruits with you. Before I had made the decision to accept Bishop Sweeney's invitation to minister to St. Gerard's parish and school, I had signed on to a program that includes three retreats, the first of which was back in March, the second of which is on Friday, August 4 through Thursday, August 10, and the last of which will be from October 5 through 11. I thank you for your patience and your prayers as I follow through on these commitments. God bless you all!



St. VINCENT MARTYR CEMETERY

Dear Parishioners,

To get a truly accurate map of the St. Vincent Martyr Cemetery, the Cemetery Committee will shortly be initiating a project with Legacy Mark and Omega Mapping Services to have a Ground Penetrating Radar Survey done of the All-Souls Section (The Older Section).

This will entail GPR equipment being pushed, in a grid like fashion, in this section. The machine does not disturb the ground.

The purpose is three-fold:

- 1. To confirm where vacant plots exist.
- 2. To determine if unmarked plots are vacant or contain burials and are just not marked.
- 3. To confirm marked plots and create a catalog of the markers.

For distinguishing which of the three categories a plot fits into, a small flag, a marking stripe or a medallion will be used.

This project is scheduled to begin the last week in July or the first week in August, weather permitting. For those who are interested, the personnel from Omega Mapping Services will give a demonstration of the process the day after they are set up.

We respectfully ask for your cooperation throughout this onsite process, which will take about two weeks. Please do not remove any flags or markers. The GPR service will remove everything when they are finished.
