As I write this article, I was supposed to have been on a plane to Maui for a family vacation with my brother, sister, and brother-in-law. As you know, those plans changed in the face of the devastating fires that swept the island, causing such terrible death and destruction. Our hearts go out to the

Hawaiian people in this time of great suffering. May God sustain them in His love and move the hearts of many people to reach out in assistance to those in need. Let us pray for the souls that were lost, for their eternal peace and that their families and friends be consoled and comforted. When I think about what our brothers and sisters in Maui are enduring it puts everything in perspective – my cancelled trip is totally insignificant in the face of their struggles. Again, let us keep them in prayer.

Keeping things in perspective in our lives is not always easily accomplished. We can get so caught up in the rush of life that we literally miss the forest for the trees – we easily lose sight of the bigger picture that will put the smaller things in right context. There is a need in our lives to take time to pause, to take a moment to breathe and to reconnect with the purpose and meaning of our existence, which is to align ourselves with God's will and put ourselves in service of His plan. My recent wilderness retreat in the Rocky Mountains of Colorado was one of those necessary pauses for me.

Prior to the retreat I was feeling really disconnected. It was like my brain was moving faster than my body and my heart was working overtime keeping up. One of the ways I described that feeling was that my inside self and my outside self were not working together! I needed a spiritual alignment, which I received as a grace on the retreat. It was interesting how the weather on the retreat reflected the movement of my soul! At times the sky was bright blue, and the sun was shining brightly. Then the next moment a strong wind blew down from the mountain, the sky darkened, the thunder rumbled, and rain came like a torrent. And then after the storm the sun appeared again, and a beautiful rainbow spanned across the sky.

Fr. Richard Rohr might describe this as the order, disorder and reorder that accompanies spiritual growth. I was called on this retreat to go deeper and deeper within, to recognize and reaffirm my basic identity as a beloved son of God. To get there I needed to challenge myself to let go of my attachment to being liked and affirmed. I had to struggle with the sins of pride and vanity.

At one part of the retreat, we were alone in the night, encouraged to make friends with the dark. I felt like Nicodemus going to Jesus in the night and being told by the Lord he needed to be born again of the Spirit. I believe that I had that experience. As I looked at night, the sky, filled with an abundance of stars shining down their light, illuminating the horizon like a thousand candles in the dark, I knew I was held by a power greater than myself, the power of love, the power of our faithful God. Knowing this I felt all the pieces come together, I felt whole, I felt holy. And it was all due to God's amazing grace.

Friends, never doubt the power of the pause. It draws us into the mystery of God, into His love for you and me and everyone. It is where we are meant to live. God bless!

"GREAT IS YOUR FAITH!"

While Jesus declares this to the Canaanite woman in this week's Gospel, what if we convert it into a question from Jesus: How great is your faith? Often, we can take our prayer life and our relationship with Jesus for granted. It is easy to get into a routine, go through the motions and ultimately, lose sight of the fact that as much as Jesus is after us, we have to be after Him. And being after Him is living our life for the other. Living for our neighbors, our family, and our friends. Doing things out of the ordinary for another, even if it costs us something. That is what Jesus did and still does for us, and we need to be after Him with the same vigor as that of the Canaanite woman. She is not an Israelite, yet she recognizes Jesus as the savior and, inspired by her desperation to help her daughter, believes, and has faith in Jesus. So, over this week, as we pray, let us confront ourselves with the question: How great is my faith? And as we pray on this, may we let the Spirit inspire us to act and live *for* others with the same zeal and eagerness displayed by the Canaanite woman.

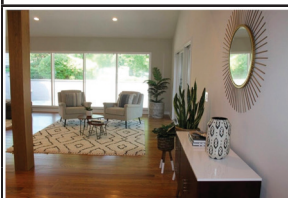
