Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

September 10, 2023



My return to Saint Gerard's in Paterson is also a return to the place I was living when our nation suffered the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, and saw the death and destruction caused by the power of evil at work in human hatred. I vividly remember walking from the church up to the rectory under the bright blue sky that morning and being stopped by a passerby who told me that a plane had crashed into the Twin Towers. I went up to my room and turned on the TV only to watch in horror as the towers went down sending hundreds of innocent people to their deaths. All that day at Saint Gerard's School, Sister Jo-Ann and I kept watch over the children until their parents could come and pick them up. I also remember a few days later returning from ground zero after doing my little bit to help as an assistant chaplain and placing my dust covered boots carefully in a corner of the garage, knowing they had tread on ground holding the remains of lost loved ones.

We have pledged as a nation never to forget what happened that day. We have promised to always remember those who were lost and in a particular way to honor the memory of those first responders who went rushing into the towers to save their fellow citizens. We have striven as a nation to respond to this tragedy by doing some act of service, by trying to make the world a better, more caring, more compassionate place. From a faith perspective we have realized that every manifestation of evil must be met with the force of Christ's love, believing that the goodness of God must and will prevail. And we know that this love ultimately calls us to not return evil for evil, but to take the path of justice and peace.

In the days that followed the terrible events in New York City, Pennsylvania, and Washington DC we turned to God for help and healing. Our churches were full, and our prayer was abundant. There was unity among people. People understood that we are called to take care of each other, to reach out to those in need. This prayer, this unity and this understanding continue to be needed today. It should not require a crisis or disaster to move us into the best version of ourselves as a city, state, or nation. This should be the ordinary way we live our lives, our everyday way of going at things.

May Monday's remembrance of 9/11 strengthen our resolve to stand firmly against words, actions and attitudes that fuel the fire of hatred, that promote violence and that destroy life. Let us model to the world another way, God's way, which is the way of love and understanding, the way of peace and justice, the way of life. God bless.
