One of the things that I have learned from my mentor and teacher, the Franciscan priest Fr. Richard Rohr, is that the key to embracing a contemplative way of life is being faithful to your contemplative practice. Part of my practice is what is called a contemplative sit which I try to do for twenty minutes every morning. Ideally, I should be doing a sit later in the day also, but I am not quite up to that. Maybe that is why they call it a practice! For me, this time of prayer begins with consenting to God being present and acting on my life. Then I move into what Dr. James Finley, another of my teachers from the Living School, calls the I Love You prayer – I breathe in God’s love for me and breathe out my love for God. Through this I try to sit upright and still, my feet planted on the floor and my hands in an open position to receive God’s grace. Using my knowledge of Centering Prayer, I use my centering words, In Christ, to move back into silence whenever my thoughts begin to make too much noise. The goal of all of this is to move us out of the head and into the heart and soul, where we discover that at our core identity in the truth that we are beloved children of God, more than what we do, what we own or what people say about us.

Friends, I have found that doing a contemplative sit while you are packing up to move is a real challenge. My centering words are working overtime as they try to get me out of my head and back into the silence and stillness. It goes something like this: In Christ....how am I going to get everything packed in time for the moving truck.....In Christ.....where am I going to put everything in my new rectory....in Christ.....how did I ever accumulate so many things.....in Christ.....what do I need to keep with me at SVM until October 2.....in Christ.....how am I going to write about this experience for the bulletin.....in Christ. You get the picture. By the end of my sit, I feel like I just finished a wrestling match – and lost!

I have learned from this experience that I have a lot more practicing to do in my quest to live life from a contemplative stance. I also know that it is worth the effort. Fr. Thomas Keating, who spoke and wrote extensively on Centering Prayer, says that we must be gentle with ourselves in this process – even laugh at ourselves when we have so many thoughts getting in the way of our prayer. He invites us to enter a deeper place within, a place where we can observe our thoughts without attaching to them, without letting them define us. He describes the thoughts as ships on a waterway, coming in and going out, while we remain anchored in the sea of God’s love. Even if, like me, that waterway seems like the Port of Newark, ultimately the activity will stop, and we can rest in God and enjoy the peace that comes from abiding there. From that place we will respond rather than react to life’s challenges and difficulties. From that place we will be aware of God’s presence in all the moments of life, reaching out to us and inviting more deeply into the mystery of His love. That is the place that our soul longs to be! God bless.

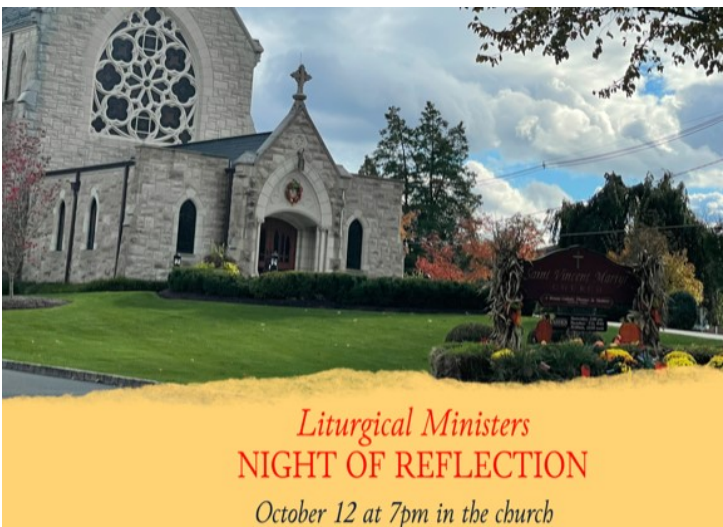





"IT'S JUST NOT FAIR"

When we feel like we were short-changed, we hear the child's voice inside us gripe, "It's just not fair". In today's readings, we gain an understanding that the logic of God and fairness is different from that of the world. What does this mean for us, as good disciples and stewards? In today's gospel reading, the landowner goes out into his field at different times of the day to hire workers and at the end of the day, he pays them all the same wage. This caused the laborers who had worked longest to complain to the landowner. But those workers were relying on human logic and human measures. They were not thinking as God does.

This can happen to us Christian stewards as well. We can complain (at least internally) when we compare ourselves to others and sense that not everyone is contributing as much as we are to the parish, the neighborhood, our work environments, within our family and so on. It is then that we need to think bigger! We must remember that it is a great privilege to have been called by the Father to work in His vineyard. The more time we are given to do this work, the greater the gift! Let us be grateful for the privilege to do more!
