### Twenty-Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Challenge: Remember a time when you were welcomed and show that same welcome to Father Owen.


#### SEMINARIAN BAG OUTREACH

#### "IF HE TURNS FROM...WICKEDNESS...AND DOES WHAT IS RIGHT AND JUST, HE SHALL PRESERVE HIS LIFE."

The readings this week serve as a good reminder for us that, when it comes to our faith and our discipleship, we have a choice and our actions (and inactions) matter, a lot. Jesus will ask us to be His disciple. He will invite us. But He will never force us to follow Him. We do not get to be a follower in name only. We have to *choose*, in every moment, to be His disciple. When we choose, we demonstrate our discipleship by, as St. Paul reminds us, "looking out not for [our] own interests, but also for those of others." Jesus said, "Follow me" and if we are going to do so, we follow Mary's instruction at Cana and "do whatever he tells you" whenever he asks and for whomever He asks. To be known to the world as a follower of Jesus and to truly follow Him, we have to be like Him and, therefore, be *for the other* no matter the cost to us. This is how we can grow closer to Jesus and let Him shine through us so that we can start living eternally…now.




Outreach is one of five priority areas that the Pastoral Council has been charged with working on for the growth of our parish. The focus of Outreach is to honor the dignity of every person through direct service and advocacy. All our efforts are grounded in the principles of Catholic social teaching (CST). (Our mission statement can be found on SVM's website.)

Father George suggested that we spend our first year as a group of Pastoral Council members and parishioners learning and discussing CST. According to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the seven themes of CST are: life and dignity of the human person, call to family community and participation, option for the poor and vulnerable, the dignity of work and the rights of workers, rights and responsibilities, solidarity, and care for creation. Spending time discussing and prayerfully reflecting on these themes helped us appreciate the challenge we all face in truly living our faith.

Our group is moving from the study to the doing phase and we invite you to join us. We have transitioned out of Pastoral Council and are now known as the Social Outreach Ministry. We will be writing articles in the bulletin for the next several months presenting the themes of CST. We will offer an outside speaker to present the themes to those parishioners interested in learning more. SVM is blessed to have many dedicated parishioners who currently lead ministries serving the poor and marginalized. In the coming months, the Social Outreach Ministry plans to gain a better understanding of how to support those existing ministries and direct parishioners who are looking for opportunities to serve. Advocacy is another area we will focus on in the coming year.




