Dear Parishioners,

We had a wonderful Antioch Retreat last weekend. Our team members did a really good job with their talks and interacted with the candidates. I was glad to begin the retreat with a Mass with the team leaders on Friday and conclude with 3 pm Mass on Sunday with the entire group, parents and families. Antioch always brings huge energy to the parish and kids really love being together and forming stronger bonds with Christ. A big thank you to Anne Marie Gisoldi, Joanne and Jody who prepare and help our teams to be effective in this wonderful ministry.

We recently received a gift of two beautiful new chasubles, which is the vestment that the priest wears and a dalmatic, which is the vestment that the deacon wears. These are vestments that can be worn during Lent and Advent. As you can see, they are purple with a red stripe. These colors and designs remind us that as Catholics we are a royal people loved by God and invited to see the dignity of every human being as God sees them. The red stripe reminds us of the need to suffer and die to ourselves in order to live in Christ. The vestments were given in honor of Jeanne and Michael Newman from their family for their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the second in memory of Ann Casey given by family and friends following her recent funeral here in December. Thank you to the Newman family and to the family and friends of Ann Casey for these beautiful vestments. To give a vestment to the church, is a beautiful gesture, the priest remembers the donors as he celebrates Mass and the donor's feel a special connection seeing the vestment that they have donated is being worn.

We were all thrilled that so many came for confessions last Monday. From 6-8:00 pm all six priests were busy, and people kept coming. As a priest, there is nothing more satisfying than seeing the joy and gratification on a person's face as they receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation. ## Diocesan Synodal Listening Session

As the Synod of Bishops in Rome begins to process the results of its assembly last October, and to prepare for its next assembly in October 2024, it has asked dioceses to participate in an “interim phase” of the Synod on Synodality during this coming Lent.

Specifically, the Secretariat of the Synod has asked for further consultation with the People of God through local listening sessions. The input from these sessions will be included in a diocesan synthesis report that will be sent to the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops in early April. Its synthesis of the input from US dioceses will be forwarded to the Vatican in May.



Tenebrae, translated as "shadows" or "darkness" in Latin is an ancient holy week service that features distinctive symbolic elements of Christ's passion and death.

During the service, which combines song, scripture, and silence, candles are extinguished one by one as Scripture readings are shared to tell the story of Holy Week. This gradual descent into darkness is a representation of the increasing sorrow of Jesus as the events of Holy Week unfolded. After the last verse is read, the last candle is extinguished, and the room is plunged into darkness as the Lux Aeterna is sung.

Tenebrae is designed to serve as a powerful, reflective experience ahead of the sacred Triduum. The representation of the darkness of sin and death serve to call us as Catholic Christians to embrace the light of Christ, who has conquered death.

This Lent we offer you the opportunity to prayerfully reflect on the **Tres Ore**, the Three Hours of Agony while Jesus hung on the Cross.

We will study the text and spend time in reflection and prayer.

Traditionally, these seven words (which are more like "sayings" that contain more than a single word) are known as words of Forgiveness, Salvation, Relationship, Abandonment, Distress, Triumph, and Reunion. But, the story doesn't end with the crucifixion; there is the hope we celebrate at Easter.

This Lent, let's take a moment to acknowledge the suffering sacrifice of our Savior. Reflecting on these words of Jesus gives us the opportunity for gratitude for His steadfast love and faithfulness that led Him to lay down His life for us and to recognize that sacrifice in the gift of Eucharist.

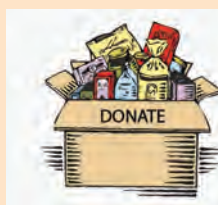
### **Are you feeling creative?**

Queridos feligreses,


