My dear parishioners,

Fr. Yojan, Marta, Fr. Alex, Carlos, and I attended the fundraiser for St. Gerard's school last Sunday, May 18th. The fundraiser was held at The Brownstone in Paterson, which is always a great place to go. I was very pleased to see so many SVM parishioners supporting the mission of Catholic education. St. Gerard Majella school is celebrating 60 years of excellence in Catholic education, serving the children of Paterson and empowering them to be who God called them to be. We are proud to support Fr. George. I admire and respect him so much and I am thrilled to see that his enrollment is increasing. As the last Catholic school in Paterson, we, together, must help with its' continued success.

Last Wednesday, Fr. Yojan accompanied his mother back to Medellin. It was delightful to have Marta spend time at the rectory and I was thrilled to see her planning with Fr. Yojan the big move to Resurrection Parish in Randolph. Right now, Fr. Yojan is on a retreat and in the coming days he will remember his dad's 5th anniversary of his death. We wish him a Happy 11th Anniversary of priesthood and assure him of our prayers in this period of transition. We wish Fr. Jose a Happy 3rd Anniversary of priesthood as he celebrates his anniversary this coming Wednesday, May 28th.

In the last couple of years Bishop Sweeney has had every seminarian live a pastoral year in a parish in our diocese. Carlos finished at Immaculate Conception last week and is presently on a spiritual retreat. He has been assigned to St. Anthony's Parish in Passaic effective July 8th. We wish Carlos well in these coming months as he continues the path towards ordination. Let's continue to keep Carlos in our prayers and be sure to keep in touch with him during these exciting months.

As you all know, I am very aware and concerned about the plight of the working poor. How difficult it must be to work so hard and yet struggle financially. God bless each of you for this tremendous gift of love. I am overjoyed each family discussed this very vital charity, and we have been sensitized and moved by the lives of our brothers and sisters who live in Passaic, Paterson and Dover areas.

Last Saturday Fr. Jose and Fr. Yojan celebrated First Holy Communion for our 16 Spanish speaking children. The mass was beautiful and filled with joy and enthusiasm. This brought to completion 6 groups of Holy Communion and 2 smaller groups at our regular masses. I am excited to tell you that our Faith Formation catechists and our school teachers under the direction of Steven Serafin and Sister Noreen prepared 149 children for First Holy Communion. Let's pray that our children always remember their special day and come frequently to the table of the Lord. Thanks to all who helped to prepare our little angels.

Please remember that Mass on Monday, Memorial Day, will be celebrated at 8 am at the cemetery. Fr. Jose will preside and afterwards he's looking forward to marching in the town parade for the first time. It is a wonderful way to honor our men and women who served our country and all those currently serving. Happy Memorial Day, my dear parishioners. Enjoy time with family and friends this weekend.

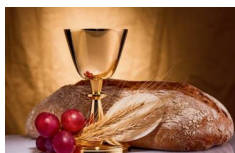

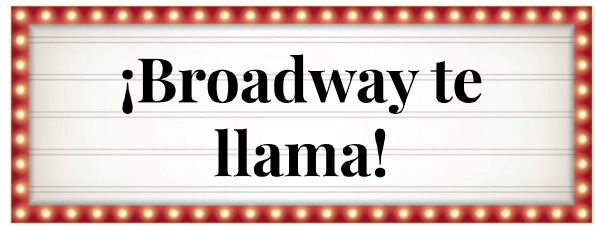
