My dear parishioners,

As we gather on this Sunday, we call to mind and celebrate Jesus Christ ascending back to heaven. We consider that on March 25th, the Annunciation of the Lord, Mary said yes to the will of the Father and conceived Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit. Jesus, as we know, was born on Christmas day, he was born at a time of transition in the Roman empire. The empire was going through a decline after His birth and His family became aliens in Egypt because of the tyrant, King Herod. His childhood would have been partly shaped by the family's exile in Egypt and then their return home to Israel. He lived as a carpenter, having learned his trade from his stepfather, Joseph. At 30 years of age, he began his public ministry and changed the world. He showed us His Father in heaven as a loving and forgiving God head. He took away the fear of Yahweh and led His small community in loving compassion and showed them how to minister to the marginalized. Thanks to all of us here at SVM who continue as strong pilgrims on the journey and also being aware of the alien and marginalized knowing we are all equal in God's sight and that we love and care for each other.

This coming Saturday I look forward to confirming Danielle Pimienta at the 5pm mass. At the 7pm mass, I will confirm 9 people. Pentecost concludes the season when the pastor can confirm who have been prepared for Confirmation. On Monday the 9th and Thursday the 12th, I look forward to welcoming Bishop Serratelli and Bishop Sweeney to confirm our 10th grade students. Let's keep these young men and women in prayer during these special days.

As you read this article, I am delighted to tell you I am in Ireland. I flew to Ireland late on Wednesday night and return home on Tuesday afternoon. My niece Maeve Moran graduates from The Royal College of Surgeons Dublin on Monday, June 2nd!! Maeve and I are very close. My gift to her is a medal of St. Luke, the physician and caretaker of St. Paul the Apostle. My prayer for my darling niece is that she will serve as a doctor with a loving, sensitive heart allowing her hands to be healing hands through the love of Jesus and Mary. Maeve has worked very hard these past few years and of course, as a resident, will work even harder, but I know she will make a difference in the world. While here in Ireland, I am spending time with my beloved aunties Maura and Claire, my siblings and family. It's always good to be with family and to celebrate the special moments of life together. I look forward to telling you all about this wonderful time upon my return.

Mis queridos feligreses,

Al reunirnos este domingo, recordamos y celebramos la ascensión de Jesucristo al cielo. Recordamos que el 25 de marzo, día de la Anunciación del Señor, María aceptó la voluntad del Padre y concibió a Jesucristo por obra del Espíritu Santo. Jesús, como sabemos, nació el día de Navidad.
