My dear parishioners,

As we gather this weekend of Pentecost, we bring the season of Easter to a conclusion. Last weekend, we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord. We remember His words of encouragement: "Where I have gone ahead of you, you will follow." This weekend, we celebrate the Holy Spirit coming upon the early Christian community to empower them with courage, wisdom, and fortitude to be who Christ called them to be. For us gathered here this weekend, we, too, are renewed by the Holy Spirit to use our gifts to promote Christ's message here in Madison and beyond. Keep in prayer Danielle, whom I confirmed this weekend at the 5 p.m. Mass, and our other nine parishioners, whom I also confirmed at the 7 p.m. Mass. Please keep our 10th graders in prayer when Bishop Serratelli and Bishop Sweeney celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation.

My goal is to have representation of every parish ministry leadership team connect with the ministry under their care and report on a regular basis to the team and me. In this way, we can plan cohesively to ensure each ministry is run efficiently but with compassion and vision. Our further goal is to plan five years ahead so that we can see, through prayer, reflection, and advice, where we need to be as a parish—specifically calling to mind our people, our church building, and parish plant. I will write more about this next weekend, and in the coming weeks, I will detail the role of each parish council member and then place this information online with a photograph of each member along with their contact information.

Congratulations to the Class of 2025 from St. Vincent Martyr School! As you graduate from our Catholic middle school and move on to your respective high schools, know that your parish family is proud of all you have accomplished. As your pastor, I pray you carry the light of Christ with you—guided by faith, strengthened by knowledge, and inspired by the Holy Spirit. May you continue to grow as compassionate, courageous young men and women who make a difference in the world.

I arrived back from Dublin, Ireland, on Tuesday afternoon. I am so proud of my niece, Dr. Maeve C. Moran, who graduated from The Royal College of Surgeons on Monday, June 2nd. We had a wonderful lunch as a family to celebrate this milestone and my dear niece. I keep her in prayer that, as a strong, faithful doctor, she will reflect the gifts of St. Luke, glorious physician. It was very lovely to spend time with my aged aunties and to just be with family. I'm glad to be back—June is a busy and exciting month. So, back to work I go!!!!

A Word of Gratitude and Mission

"Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms" (1 Peter 4:10)

Over the past few weeks, some of you have kindly asked about my role following the announcement of my new appointment. I understand that I may not always be visible in the parish during the week, and I'd like to take a moment to share a bit more about the ministry I carry out and the mission I have been entrusted with, both here and beyond.

My full-time ministry is as Diocesan Director of the Office of Catechesis. In this role, I serve as a representative of our bishop in all matters related to faith formation. My mission includes visiting parishes across the diocese, training new catechetical leaders and catechists, consulting with pastors and parish teams, and ensuring that the Church's vision for catechesis becomes a living reality in our local Church.

My office is based at St. Paul Inside the Walls in Madison, but my work reaches throughout the diocese, and beyond. Nationally, I serve as Vice President of the Federation for Catechesis with Hispanics, an organization that equips leaders for catechetical ministry across the country. Additionally, I am a consultant for the National Institute on the Catechism of the Catholic Church, which is under the guidance of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops. In this capacity, I support and accompany diocesan catechetical leaders to strengthen the Church's teaching mission.

For the past four years, I have had the joy of living in residence at St. Vincent. It has been a privilege to accompany the Hispanic community and to celebrate the sacraments with many of you in English too. I treasure the moments we have shared at Mass, in parish events, and in simple conversations. As many of you know, I love being with people, and I only wish I had more time to be present with you.

Beginning July 1st, I will also begin a new chapter of ministry as Pastor of a parish, Resurrection, Randolph, while continuing in my current diocesan and national responsibilities. This is both a humbling and exciting new call to serve.

I'm also grateful to share that this summer I will begin an Executive Master's Program in Leadership at Boston College, made possible by a full scholarship. This program will take place over a few summers and include occasional coursework throughout the year. It will strengthen my ability to lead, to serve, and to empower others as servant leaders in the Church.

I kindly ask for your prayers, above all, for the grace of the Holy Spirit and the gift of health, that I may serve faithfully and joyfully. My deepest desire is that when I stand before the Lord one day, I will have been a candle fully consumed in love and service, burning brightly until the very end.

Although I will no longer reside at St. Vincent, I carry you in my heart. In my country, we have a saying: "Visit me, let's share a cup of coffee, and remain friends."

You remain in my prayers always. I love you dearly.

Una Palabra de Gratitud y Misión - P. Yojan García

En las últimas semanas, algunos de ustedes han tenido la amabilidad de preguntar sobre mi función tras el anuncio de mi nuevo nombramiento. Entiendo que no siempre puedo estar presente en la parroquia durante la semana, y me gustaría tomarme un momento para compartir un poco más sobre el ministerio que realizo y la misión que se me ha encomendado, tanto aquí como fuera de ella.

Mi ministerio a tiempo completo es el de Director Diocesano de la Oficina de Catequesis. En este puesto, represento a nuestro obispo en todos los asuntos relacionados con la formación en la fe. Mi misión incluye visitar parroquias de toda la diócesis, capacitar a nuevos líderes catequéticos y catequistas, asesorar a los párrocos y equipos parroquiales, y asegurar que la visión de la Iglesia para la catequesis se convierta en una realidad en nuestra Iglesia local.

Mi oficina está ubicada en St. Paul Inside the Walls en Madison, pero mi trabajo se extiende a toda la diócesis y más allá. A nivel nacional, soy Vicepresidente de la Federación para la Catequesis con Hispanos, una organización que capacita a líderes para el ministerio catequético en todo el país. Además, soy consultor del Instituto Nacional del Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, bajo la dirección de la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos. En esta función, apoyo y acompaño a los líderes catequéticos diocesanos para fortalecer la misión docente de la Iglesia.

Durante los últimos cuatro años, he tenido la alegría de vivir en la residencia de San Vicente. Ha sido un privilegio acompañar a la comunidad hispana y celebrar los sacramentos con muchos de ustedes, también en inglés. Atesoro los momentos que hemos compartido en la misa, en los eventos parroquiales y en las conversaciones sencillas. Como muchos saben, me encanta estar con la gente y desearía tener más tiempo para estar presente con ustedes.

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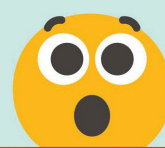
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
