My dear parishioners,

On Sunday, June 22nd the members of the Order of Malta went to Spring Lake to have an important get together. We began with mass at St. Catherine's Church. The presider was Most Reverend Bishop O'Connell of Trenton assisted by Bishop-Elect Bismarck Chau, the priest's chaplains; Fr. Phil, Fr. Alex and I are all prison chaplains and a guest priest Fr. Bob. The Order of Malta has been in existence for 1,000 years, anybody interested in knowing more about the Order simply google it. We began at the time of the crusaders to fight for freedom and to practice freedom of Christianity that had been taken over by the Muslims. Nowadays, happily, we have no crusaders marching to the Holy land and no fleet of ships. Instead, we reach out and serve the prisoners, the sick and the dying. Every year we bring a large contingent of sick and dying to Lourdes and give them the strength and peace that comes from the Blessed Mother. To be chosen as a member of the Order a man, prospective Knight, a woman, a prospective Dame must be Catholic and open to the works of the Order. Anybody interested in hearing more about the Order after having googled it, please see me. Paul DiSilva, a devout member of our parish and a member of my prison ministry team, was honored last Sunday for serving 10 years in the Order of Malta, congrats to him and Maria, his wife.

Last Tuesday, I had our Eucharistic Ministers to the homebound at the rectory for tea and scones. Our ministers to the homebound are kind, caring and Christ centered people who serve those in our 6 facilities within Madison. They visit the elderly and shut-ins in our town/parish. A big thanks to our EM's and Jody Costello who runs this beautiful, caring ministry.

We were delighted to host bible camp to 56 children this past week. A big thanks to Steven Serafin our Faith Formation director who runs the program, Mary Ann Paladino and her team. We were blessed to have 20 middle school/high school teens to help as well. The children learned a lot, had fun and made new friends.

I am so proud to be an American! I became a citizen in the year 2000. Nine years after coming to the US, this holiday of July 4th is truly a great day to celebrate our nation of whom we are very proud. We think of the early fathers of our country and how they tried to give liberty and freedom to people who previously didn't have either. In the early 1900's, women finally were given the right and the freedom to vote, and the world began to change in a good direction. In this year of 2025, as we consider the USA, we consider people who are made up of both male and female, with different colors and backgrounds, who together through many forms of leadership guide and protect our nation and help to ensure quality of life for Americans and those who live in our land.

On this holiday the appropriate celebration is a small picnic without fuss where family and friends get together and share barbecue and cold foods. Together, we take time out to appreciate our country and those who have established our country from the beginning. Comenzamos en la época de las cruzadas para luchar por la libertad y practicar la libertad del cristianismo, que había sido conquistada por los musulmanes. Hoy, afortunadamente, no tenemos cruzados marchando hacia Tierra Santa ni una flota de barcos. En cambio, nos acercamos y servimos a los prisioneros, enfermos y moribundos. Cada año traemos un gran contingente de enfermos y moribundos a Lourdes y les damos la fuerza y la paz que provienen de la Santísima Madre. Para ser elegido miembro de la Orden, un hombre, un futuro Caballero, una mujer o una futura Dama debe ser católico y estar abierto a las obras de la Orden. Tuvimos la suerte de contar con la ayuda de 20 adolescentes de secundaria y preparatoria. Los niños aprendieron mucho, se divirtieron e hicieron nuevos amigos.
