My dear parishioners,

With great joy and gratitude, we begin the celebration of Catholic Schools Week. What wonderful history we have here in Madison. Our school was founded by the Sisters of Charity in 1806 and remains in capable hands today through Sister Noreen, our very own Sister of Charity. Sister Noreen, along with our dedicated Vice Principal, Anne Marie Gisoldi, and our devoted teachers and staff, lead a strong academic school firmly centered on Christ. Here, each child is encouraged to become the best version of themselves and to develop the gifts God has given them. I am proud and honored to serve as pastor of this great school and to help carry on its tradition of academic excellence for many years to come. My vision for our school families is that, through active participation in Mass and living out our Catholic values, our faith will be passed on from generation to generation. My hope is that our little kids and big kids alike will grow to become strong, faithful members in our pews and of the surrounding Catholic parishes.

Each week, I greatly enjoy teaching our 7th and 8th graders religion and other faith-based subjects in the wonderful atmosphere of the church. I especially enjoy watching them act out Gospel stories at our Wednesday school Mass. I continue to see the 6th graders as my schedule allows. I also love interacting with our 2nd graders, and these days our focus is preparing for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

I have been friends with the Marconi family since my early days at St. Patrick's in Chatham. On Thursday the 15th, I anointed Carol Romano Marconi at the wonderful care facility where she was so well cared for. I then celebrated her funeral on Saturday, January 24th. Carol was born and raised in Madison. She and Nick, her husband, were married in our church before moving to Chatham. Her brother was Fr. Gene Romano of Hermitage in Chester now deceased, and her brother-in-law is the Most Reverend Dominick Marconi, who is now retired. I extend our prayers to their five children and the entire Marconi family. As I laid Carol to rest beside Nick in our cemetery, I reflected on how she had completed the full circle of life: a devout Catholic, a loving daughter and sister, a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. May she rest in peace.

As you know, I traveled to Washington, DC, on Wednesday afternoon and returned home on Friday evening, the 23rd. Though the days were busy, they were filled with great joy and hope. Fr. Alex, Fr. Phil, and I had the privilege of leading the Knights and Dames of the Order of Malta. During our time there, we celebrated Mass and spent time in prayer and reflection with the Sisters of Life. I am proud to have proclaimed the dignity of human life in our nation's Capitol. As I mentioned in my homily this past weekend, life encompasses every stage, from its beginning in the womb through natural death. Every human being is deserving of dignity and respect, and as a society, we are called to nurture the gifts God has given to all.

Last week, I appointed Barbara Doyle and Beth Poore as coordinators of our new Volunteer Ministry. Inside the bulletin, you will find a letter from them outlining our mission. In the coming weeks, they will be reaching out to all our volunteer groups. Their dedication to our parish will allow me to spend more time in pastoral ministry. Thank you, Barbara and Beth, for saying yes!

On behalf of our Catholic school families, I thank our parents and grandparents for their commitment to living our Catholic values, and I thank all in our parish who faithfully pass on our Catholic identity: intellectually, academically, and spiritually. May you enjoy the beautiful celebrations of this special week.

La Hermana Noreen, junto con nuestra dedicada Subdirectora, Anne Marie Gisoldi, y nuestros comprometidos maestros y personal, dirigen una sólida escuela académica firmemente centrada en Cristo. Aquí, cada niño es alentado a convertirse en la mejor versión de sí mismo y a desarrollar los dones que Dios le ha dado. Me siento orgulloso y honrado de servir como párroco de esta gran escuela y de ayudar a continuar su tradición de excelencia académica por muchos años más. Mi visión para nuestras familias escolares es que, mediante la participación activa en la Misa y viviendo nuestros valores católicos, nuestra fe se transmita de generación en generación. Gene Romano de Hermitage en Chester, ya fallecido, y su cuñado es el Reverendísimo Dominick Marconi, ahora retirado. Extendemos nuestras oraciones a sus cinco hijos y a toda la familia Marconi. Al sepultar a Carol junto a Nick en nuestro cementerio, reflexioné sobre cómo había completado el círculo completo de la vida: una católica devota, hija y hermana amorosa, esposa dedicada, madre, abuela y bisabuela. Que descanse en paz.

Como saben, viajé a Washington, D.C., el miércoles por la tarde y regresé a casa el viernes por la noche, día 23. Aunque los días fueron intensos, estuvieron llenos de gran alegría y esperanza. El P. Todo ser humano merece dignidad y respeto, y como sociedad estamos llamados a cuidar los dones que Dios ha dado a todos.

La semana pasada nombré a Barbara Doyle y Beth Poore como coordinadoras de nuestro nuevo Ministerio de Voluntarios. Dentro del boletín encontrarán una carta de ellas donde explican nuestra misión. En las próximas semanas, se pondrán en contacto con todos nuestros grupos de voluntarios. Su dedicación a nuestra parroquia me permitirá dedicar más tiempo al ministerio pastoral. ¡Gracias, Barbara y Beth, por decir que sí!




