Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time
February 1, 2026

My dear parishioners,

As we gather on the 4th Sunday of Ordinary Time, we celebrate two beautiful feasts: the Presentation of the Lord and the life of St. Blaise.

We celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on Monday, February 2nd. This feast is celebrated 40 days after Christmas, marking the day when Mary and Joseph brought the infant Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem to fulfill the Law of Moses. Two elderly individuals were praying in the Temple. One was Simeon, a holy man who had been promised by God that he would not die until he had seen the Messiah. The second was St. Anna, a holy and elderly woman who prayed constantly in the Temple and was overjoyed to be in the presence of the baby Jesus, who is God. In these two devout individuals, we see the hope that Christ would bring to the world.

We have many holy people in our parish. I see them every day at the 8:30 a.m. Mass and at the various Masses throughout the weekend. Holiness is a gift and requires time spent with God in prayer and meditation, and the ability to receive the Holy Eucharist as frequently as possible. Holy people inspire and empower us to trust in God. I thank God for the holy ones in our parish of all ages, who continue to be a beacon of love for so many.

On Tuesday, February 3rd, we celebrate the Feast of St. Blaise. St. Blaise lived in Armenia and was a martyr, physician, and bishop. During medieval times, there were many blessings and blessing rituals passed on to the faithful. The Blessing of Throats is one of the few rituals that remains to this day. This blessing involves the priest pressing two candles, tied in the shape of a cross, over the throat of the faithful. The prayer of blessing reminds us that God cares for every part of us. On Tuesday, I will give individual blessings to everyone who attends the 8:30 a.m. Mass. At all the weekend masses, I will give a collective blessing at the end of each Mass, as it would sadly be impossible to give individual blessings to so many.

I am very grateful to Sean from RH Services and his crew for their hard work during last week's snowstorm. They worked all day Sunday and throughout the night clearing our parking lots and driveways and keeping us safe. We are also grateful to firefighters, police officers, emergency service workers, and all who work at Morristown Medical Center for their dedication to our communities, even in the face of bad weather.

Our snowstorm did affect Catholic Schools Week, and some events had to be rescheduled. I thank Sister Noreen, Miss Gisoldi, our teachers, staff, and many volunteers for the joyful celebration in which we highlighted our Catholic school.

Mis queridos feligreses,

Al reunirnos en el 4.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, celebramos dos hermosas fiestas: la Presentación del Señor y la vida de San Blas.

Celebramos la Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor el lunes 2 de febrero. Esta fiesta se celebra 40 días después de la Navidad, marcando el día en que María y José llevaron al niño Jesús al Templo de Jerusalén para cumplir la Ley de Moisés. Dos personas ancianas estaban orando en el Templo. Uno era Simeón, un hombre santo a quien Dios le había prometido que no moriría hasta haber visto al Mesías. La segunda era Santa Ana, una mujer santa y anciana que oraba constantemente en el Templo y se llenó de alegría al estar en presencia del niño Jesús, que es Dios. En estas dos personas piadosas vemos la esperanza que Cristo traería al mundo.

Tenemos muchas personas santas en nuestra parroquia. Las veo todos los días en la Misa de las 8:30 a.m. y en las distintas Misas durante el fin de semana. La santidad es un don y requiere tiempo con Dios en oración y meditación, así como la capacidad de recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía tan frecuentemente como sea posible. Las personas santas nos inspiran y nos fortalecen para confiar en Dios. Doy gracias a Dios por los santos de nuestra parroquia, de todas las edades, que continúan siendo un faro de amor para tantos.

El martes 3 de febrero celebramos la Fiesta de San Blas. San Blas vivió en Armenia y fue mártir, médico y obispo. Durante la Edad Media, existían muchas bendiciones y rituales de bendición transmitidos a los fieles. La Bendición de las Gargantas es uno de los pocos rituales que se mantiene hasta hoy. Esta bendición consiste en que el sacerdote presiona dos velas, cruzadas entre sí, sobre la garganta de los fieles. La oración de bendición nos recuerda que Dios cuida de cada parte de nosotros. Daré bendiciones individuales a todos los que asistan a la Misa de las 8:30 a.m. del martes. En todas las Misas del fin de semana, daré una bendición colectiva al final de cada Misa, ya que sería imposible dar bendiciones individuales a tantos.

Estoy muy agradecido con Sean de RH Services y su equipo por su arduo trabajo durante la nevada de la semana pasada. Trabajaron todo el domingo y durante la noche limpiando nuestros estacionamientos y entradas, manteniéndonos seguros. También estamos agradecidos con los bomberos, policías, personal de servicios de emergencia y todos los que trabajan en el Morristown Medical Center por su dedicación a nuestras comunidades, incluso ante el mal clima.

Nuestra tormenta de nieve afectó la Semana de las Escuelas Católicas, y algunos eventos tuvieron que ser reprogramados. Agradezco a Hermana Noreen, Miss Gisoldi, nuestros maestros, personal y muchos voluntarios por la alegre celebración en la que destacamos nuestra escuela católica.






