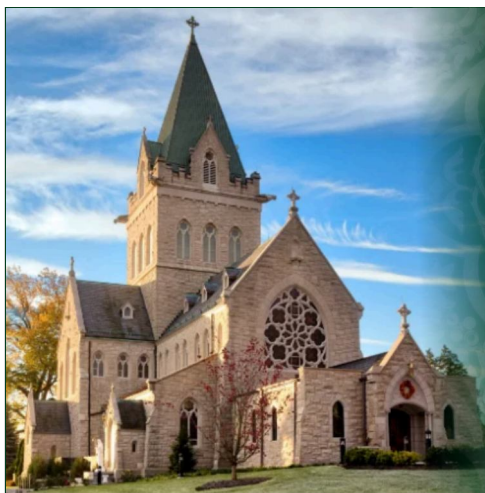




# Welcome to ST. VINCENT MARTYR CHURCH

## *My Dear Parishioners,*

You will have noticed the flags hanging from the third floor of the rectory, Belgium to the left and the French flag to the right. Fr. Alex's rooms are on the third floor. While he is a little Irish, he is mainly French and Belgian on his mother's side. With a heavy heart, he took down both Belgian and French flags due to their losses in the World Cup.

As I write this article on Monday the 13th, I am looking forward to our Feast Day of Our Lady of Mount Carmel this Thursday. As I mentioned at Masses on Sunday, please take some time to admire our beautiful tapestry, which was lovingly created in 1905. It is truly magnificent and a wonderful heirloom for our parish. The tapestry will be displayed on the back panel behind the altar for the entire month of July. As we look at this beautiful work of art, we reflect on 121 years of devotion to Jesus and Mary in our parish and beyond.

My nephew Owen and his friend Jacob have been traveling throughout the United States for the past five weeks. They stayed with us for a few days in late June and are now on the final leg of their trip, having visited Boston, Tennessee, San Francisco, Los Angeles, and Hawaii. The shed is now fully operational. Last Monday, Felipe arrived from Paterson and filled his van with the non-perishable food donations. Currently, the food pantry is accepting only non-perishable items, and they are in great need of everything. Hopefully, by September they will receive permission to store clothing and small household furnishings. I will keep you posted.

Next Monday, Mike and Noreen McManus will transport the non-perishable donations to Hope House in Dover as planned. After that, we will be arranging deliveries to Sussex County so that we can support all three areas of our diocese through our charitable outreach. Please be aware, however, that as of the 13th the shed is empty once again and needs to be replenished for the coming week. Thank you for your thoughtfulness and generosity. I know your kindness makes a real difference in the lives of those in need.

I was delighted to bless our travelers to Appalachia at the 7:15 a.m. Mass before they departed. They will return home on Saturday, and our next group leaves this weekend. Please keep them all in your prayers for safe travels and a rewarding mission experience.

Finally, I would like to welcome Albert Ganter, who has been appointed as our musician for the Sunday 5:00 p.m. Mass. He's a wizard on both the organ and the piano and has a beautiful singing voice. We are truly blessed to have him. Albert is also a music teacher at our school, and Peter and I were thrilled when he accepted our invitation. Welcome aboard, Albert, we're delighted to have you!

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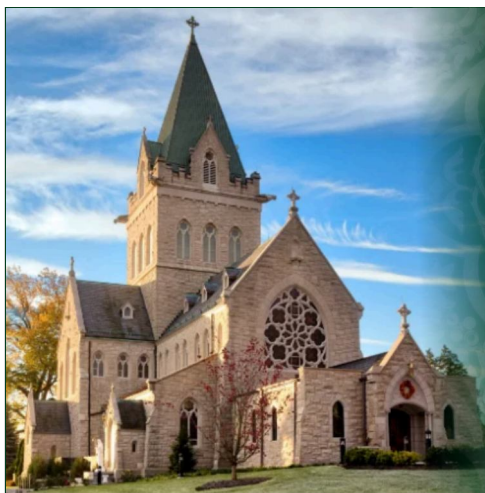

No obstante, les informo que, a fecha del día 13, el cobertizo ha quedado vacío nuevamente y necesita reabastecerse para la semana entrante. Gracias por su consideración y generosidad; sé que su bondad marca una diferencia real en la vida de quienes más lo necesitan.

Fue un placer bendecir a los miembros del grupo que viajaba a los Apalaches durante la misa de las 7:15 a. m., antes de su partida. Regresarán a casa el sábado, y nuestro siguiente grupo saldrá este fin de semana. 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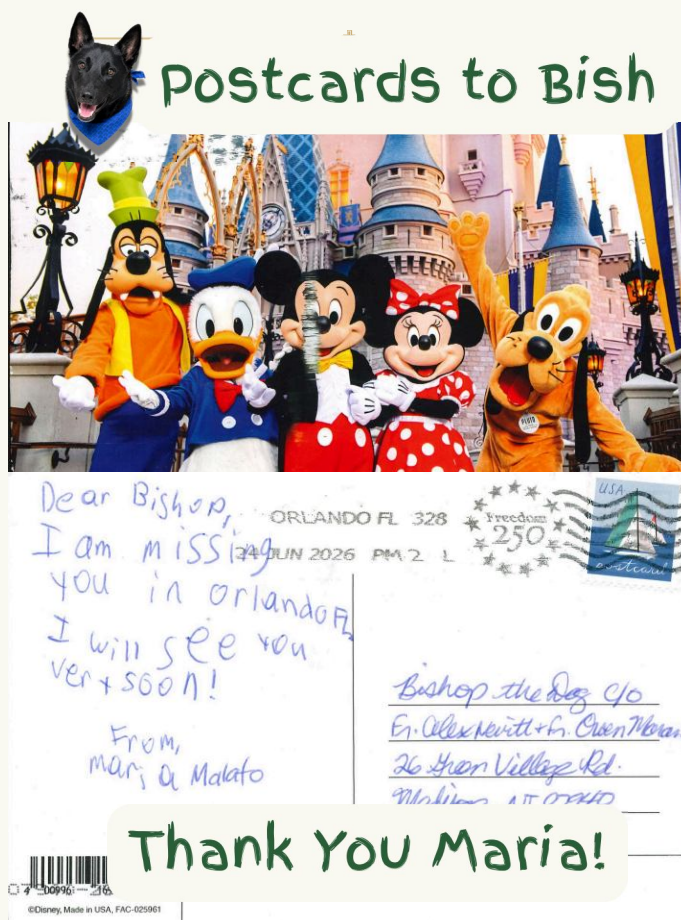

## Family Faith Formation at St. Vincent Martyr Parish



### For Families with Children in Grades PreK3 – 8th

Are you looking for a way to support your child's faith in a positive and accessible way? The truth is, nobody has more influence on a child's faith than their parents! At times, however, it can feel like a challenge to know how to support and guide your child in their faith, especially if you find yourself still learning and seeking on your own personal faith journey. We want to walk with you by offering you the resources and support you need to feel confident in bringing your faith alive at home, all while fostering deeper connections with God and with our families!



Help your kids grow in faith through meaningful moments, shared experiences, and a sense of wonder that brings them closer to God, one step at a time.

### What is Pathways all about?

Pathways is our model for Faith Formation (formerly known as CCD or Religious Education), designed to connect and support families, foster an encounter with God, learn and grow together in our Catholic faith, and empower parents with skills and support to enrich family life and faith.

### How does it work?

Each family will attend one Sunday session per month between October and April. Sessions involve Sunday Mass, gathering for a presentation on a topic in our Catholic faith, classes and activities for each grade level, and a session specifically designed for parents. Additionally, we provide take-home activities to support engaging conversations and positive experiences with faith at home!

### Is First Reconciliation & First Communion part of this program?

Yes, Pathways Family Faith Formation constitutes our parish's First Reconciliation and First Communion preparation. Preparation for First Sacraments is a two year process that normally begins in First Grade. Children in Level 2 will learn and prepare throughout the year to receive their first sacraments.

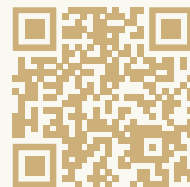
