ASCENSION MAY 21

The Feast of the Ascension commemorates Jesus ascending into heaven. For forty days the risen Christ had remained with the apostles and continued to teach and guide them for what was to come, and He prepared them for their missions of evangelization and the crosses that they would bear, including suffering and dying for the faith. Traditionally the feast is celebrated on the 40th day of the Easter Season, which this year would make it Thursday of this week. However, most provinces (groupings of dioceses) in the United States, including ours, have transferred the feast to the following Sunday, replacing the Seventh Sunday of Easter. So even though some calendars have the Ascension on May 18th and a Holy day of Obligation, we will celebrate the Ascension next Sunday, (which is always a Day of Obligation!)
