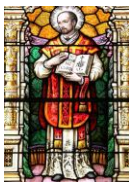

BACEF is 50! The Bismarck Area Catholic Education Foundation (BACEF) was established in 1975 by the six Bismarck area parishes as a permanent endowment fund. The earnings each year are returned to support Faith Formation and religious education programs at the parishes and schools. BACEF has made annual distributions totaling \$7.75M since 1977! BACEF increases the endowment by receiving legacy gifts, collecting memorial contributions, and conducting annual Foundation Sunday Fund Drives. This year, Foundation Sunday is November 9. We are counting on you for support again this year and thank you for your stewardship over our 50 years of service!
