JUBILEE YEAR – ANOINTING OF THE SICK MASS – OCTOBER 7

As part of the Jubilee Year of Hope, the Pro-Cathedral of St. Mary in Bismarck will be hosting a special Mass with the Anointing of the Sick on Tuesday, October 7th at 7:00 pm. During the Mass, only those individuals whose health
