FATHER’S MESSAGE

*“As they continued their journey Jesus entered a vil-  
lage where a woman whose name was Martha wel-  
comed him. She had a sister named Mary who sat be-  
side the Lord at his feet listening to him speak. Mar-  
tha, burdened with much serving, came to him and  
said, “Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me  
by myself to do the serving? Tell her to help me.” The  
Lord said to her in reply, “Martha, Martha, you are  
anxious and worried about many things. There is need  
of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and  
it will not be taken from her.” Lk 10:38-42*

One thing the Lord tries to teach us is to rely on  
Him alone and not our own strength. Self-reliance is  
very attractive but it is a lie and not helpful. In fact self-  
-reliance is what spiritually harms many people and  
fills them with fear and worry.

In the gospel above Martha is filled with worry  
and anxiety because she is trying to resolve things by  
her own strength. She is trying to direct Jesus, “Tell  
her to help me.” Instead we need Jesus to direct us. We  
were never meant to play God. We are powerless.  
When we turn to the Lord and let Him direct our lives  
we find peace and salvation.
