

Pastor's Corner

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

It is Gaudete Sunday a fancy Latin word for Rejoice Sunday! We are getting ever closer to celebrate the birthday of our Lord Jesus Christ. This weekend, the priest often wears the rose-colored vestments because it is a color of rejoicing and joy. The candle on the Advent wreathe also reflects this color as well.

I want to write this article about my favorite Advent hymn which is O Come, O Come Emmanuel. I know that this song can be used over and over again. There is a lot of history behind these lyrics. Each verse represents and tells a story of how Christ is fulfilling the prophecy of old that he is indeed the Son of God. This tradition began as early as the 8th century.

December 17

O Wisdom of our God Most High, guiding creation with power and love: come to teach us the path of knowledge!

December 18

O Leader of the House of Israel, giver of the Law to Moses on Sinai: come to rescue us with your mighty power!

December 19

O Root of Jesse's stem, sign of God's love for all his people: come to save us without delay!

December 20

O Key of David,

opening the gates of God's eternal Kingdom: come and free the prisoners of darkness!

December 21

O Radiant Dawn,

splendor of eternal light, sun of justice:

come and shine on those who dwell in darkness and in the shadow of death.

December 22

O King of all nations and keystone of the Church: come and save man, whom you formed from the dust!

December 23

O Emmanuel, our King and Giver of Law: come to save us, Lord our God!
