Pastor's Corner

"I am the true vine, and my Father is the vine grower. He takes away every branch in me that does not bear fruit, and every one that does he prunes so that it bears more fruit. You are already pruned because of the word that I spoke to you. Remain in me, as I remain in you. Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me." Jn 15:1-4

In his book "Searching for and maintaining peace," Fr. Jaques Philippe says the first step to gaining peace is to realize we are powerless. Jesus says "I am the vine, you are the branches, without me you can do nothing." It is hard to be powerless. We want to have control over our life. But the reality is: we control little to nothing.

The second part of accepting powerlessness is to surrender everything we have and everything we are over to God and seek to do His will. When we try to have power and take control of things and do our will, we are not letting God direct our lives. The key is to give up and surrender everything to God. When we do, He leads us to a far greater life and salvation.
