FATHER’S MESSAGE

“And when they came to a place called Golgotha —which means Place of the Skull —, they gave Jesus wine to drink mixed with gall. But when he had tasted it, he refused to drink. After they had crucified him, they divided his garments by casting lots; then they sat down and kept watch over him there. And they placed over his head the written charge against him: This is Jesus, the King of the Jews. Two revolutionaries were crucified with him, one on his right and the other on his left.” Mt 27:33-38

Today we begin Holy Week. This is the week of the Church calendar where we enter most deeply into all the events of the Lord Jesus’ death and resurrection. The liturgies are very rich and powerful with deep symbolism and beauty.


