
An Invitation to all Members of St Patrick's Parish

Pastor's Corner

"Jesus enjoined them, "Watch out, guard against the leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod." They concluded among themselves that it was because they had no bread. When he became aware of this he said to them, "Why do you conclude that it is because you have no bread? Do you not yet understand or comprehend? Are your hearts hardened? Do you have eyes and not see, ears and not hear? Mk 8:15-18

Scripture speaks of hardness of heart as a spiritual sickness brought about by our sins. To have a hard heart means to have one's heart be non-receptive to God and His will. The more we sin the more hard-hearted we become. Sin also causes spiritual blindness.

The goal with this is that we strive to live very holy lives. This means we work hard to stay away from sin as much as possible. We are sinners, so we can never become totally sinless in this life but we can strive to avoid sin as much as possible. Ideally, we strive to avoid evil because we have a deep love for God and we want to go to heaven. The more we love the Lord the more we get serious about avoiding sin because it pains us deeply to offend the one we love the most.
