*“Jesus said to his disciples, come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light.” Mt 11:28-30*

St. Mary’s Cemetery Board has announced that the price of a burial plot in the cemetery will be increased to \$1,000. The effective date of increase will be July 1, 2023. The new price is needed to help pay for rising maintenance costs for Cemetery upkeep.
