May God bless them as they continue to serve!

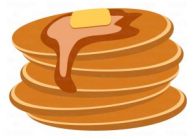
In appreciation, the servers were given Dairy Queen gift certificates donated by the St. Mary’s KC’s and CCW group, on behalf of the parish.
