


<div><div><p>Church Steeple Repair Project</p><p>Over the last year we have been watching the water damage increase in the balcony ceiling. Last December we had Krause Konstruction Company inspect the bell tower and steeple. They found some significant water damage and corrosion on the interior and exterior of the steeple and bell tower. The estimate to repair the damage came in at close to \$160,000. St Patrick's is currently raising funds to pay for these repairs.</p><p>50% of the cost of the repair/restoration is due to the contractor at completion of the project in September, with the other 50 % due in March of 2024. Letters and donation forms were recently mailed out to parish households. Please pray about this cause and give what you can to save our beautiful steeple. There will be a display in the back of church with more information and updates on the fund-raising progress.
