

Pastor's Corner

"Jesus said to His disciples, You have heard that it was said, 'An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.' But I say to you, offer no resistance to one who is evil. When someone strikes you on your right cheek, turn the other one to him as well. If anyone wants to go to law with you over your tunic, hand him your cloak as well. Should anyone press you into service for one mile, go with him for two miles. Give to the one who asks of you, and do not turn your back on one who wants to borrow. Mt 5:38-42

Sometimes when we are unjustly hurt or someone "strikes us on one cheek," instead of turning the other cheek we are tempted to strike them back instead of turning the other cheek as Jesus commands us. And sometimes we feel like we can justify our return attack. But the problem with "an eye for an eye" is that everybody is left toothless and eyeless. You cannot defeat Satan with Satan. Evil can only be conquered by love.

Our Lord was the great example of this, when He asked the Father to forgive those who had tortured and crucified Him, "Father forgive them for they know not what they do." We must not perpetuate evil. Jesus says we must forgive and pray for our enemies and love them (Mt 5:44). That is the only way we will produce peace in our hearts and peace in the world.
