# **Church Steeple Repair Project**

Over the last year we have been watching the water damage increase in the balcony ceiling. Last December we had Krause Konstruction Company inspect the bell tower and steeple. They found some significate water damage and corrosion on the interior and exterior of the steeple and bell tower. The estimate to repair the damage came in at close to \$160,000.

St Patrick's is currently raising funds to pay for these repairs.

50% of the cost of the repair/restoration is due to the contractor at completion of the project in September, with the other 50 % due in March of 2024. Letters and donation forms were recently mailed out to parish households. Please pray about this cause and give what you can to save our beautiful steeple. There will be a display in the back of church with more information and updates on the fund-raising progress. Thank you for your generous support to maintain the house that God built.

There will be a Pancake Breakfast in the hall on Sunday July 9 9 am – 11 am (or until gone) Proceeds will go to St Clement's Cemetery.



## **Pastor's Corner**

Hello to all the families and friends of St. Mary's and St. Patrick's! Thank you so much for the warm welcome and the opportunity for me to come and be your new pastor. I am very excited for this opportunity to get to know you and your families.

My name is Fr. Thế Hoàng and my first name is pronounced Tay. You can tell that I have been through this drill before with a unique name like that. My parents were from Vietnam. I was born and raised in Owatonna, MN. I went to St. Mary's School and Owatonna High School. The call to priesthood was always there but I was too young to realize what God was truly asking of me. I just knew that I wanted to give my life to Him and make a difference in the world. I had a great elementary school teacher that really inspired me to be the best Catholic that I can be and to truly live for God as his disciples. I was inspired by her example so I decided to become a teacher and to work with the kids to help forge a better future with them. God used this desire of teaching to lead me to the priesthood, although it took a while to get there.

I was involved with music such as singing in the choirs and playing the piano and organ for St. Joseph's which was my home parish. I love a lot of sports and was involved with a lot such as Soccer.
