# **Church Steeple Repair Project**


Over the last year we have been watching the water damage increase in the balcony ceiling. Last December we had Krause Konstruction Company inspect the bell tower and steeple. They found some significant water damage and corrosion on the interior and exterior of the steeple and bell tower.

The estimate to repair the damage came in at close to \$160,000.

St Patrick's is currently raising funds to pay for these repairs. Our most recent Steeple Pledge total update is \$154,006.04 Thank you for your generous support to maintain the house that God built.
