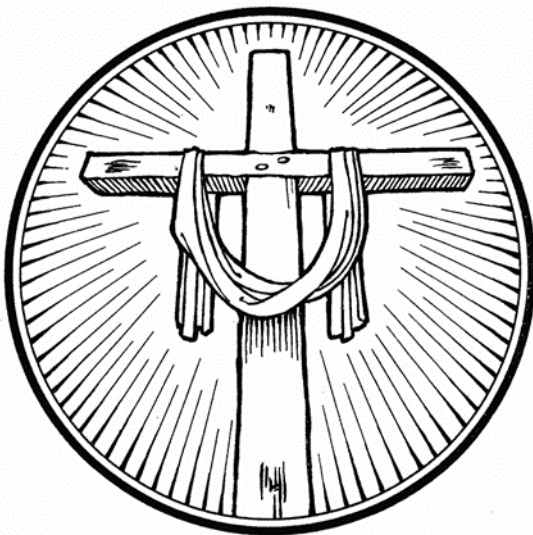
EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL FAITH-SHARING GROUPS
