July 13 - 17 for grades 7-12 and July 14-18 for grades 1-6. Totus Tuus is a Catholic SUMmer youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic Faith! The goal is to help young people grow in the understanding of and strengthen their faith with Jesus Christ.

Totus Tuus calls upon college students and seminarians from across the United States to carry this mission to every young person they encounter.
