April 3, 2022

The end of Lent quickly approaches — next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. It's not too early, I think, to beginning getting the Holy Week schedule publicized.

Palm Sunday Masses: Saturday, April 9, at 5 p.m. in English; Sunday, April 10, at 9:30 a.m. in English and at 12:30 p.m. in Spanish. This is the normal weekend schedule.

Monday and Tuesday of Holy Week, April 11 and April 12: no daily Masses at OLOL. Fr. José and I will be in Charleston for the Chrism Mass.

Wednesday of Holy Week, April 13: Mass at 8:30 a.m. Confessions from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please note that this is the final scheduled opportunity for Confession prior to Easter.

Holy Thursday, April 14: Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper (bi-lingual) at 6:30 p.m.

Good Friday, April 15: Service in English at 3:00 p.m.; Service in Spanish at 7:00 p.m.

Holy Saturday/Easter Vigil, April 16: Mass in English at 7:00 p.m.; Mass in Spanish at 9:30 p.m.

Easter Sunday, April 17: Mass in English at 9:30 a.m.; Mass in Spanish at 12:30 p.m.
