May 15, 2022 FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

The visit of the relics of St. Bernadette (May 4 to May 8) was a quite a busy time in the parish. Throughout the visit, we had a steady stream of visitors/pilgrims, but the heaviest day, as you might expect, was Saturday. People came from all over South Carolina, as well as North Carolina, Georgia, and Tennessee. Some came from as far as upstate New York, and one family from France, visiting in Greenville, heard about the relics and made the hour-long drive down. Many parishioners volunteered to serve as guardians of the relics during the visit, and my thanks and gratitude go out to them. My thanks also go out to the parishioners who volunteered to serve in various capacities at the two Virtual Pilgrimages to Lourdes which were offered by representatives of the North American Lourdes Volunteers. Of course, a thank-you and a well-done must go out to Sarah Hecox, our music director, and to our choir for the music they provided throughout the visit. Finally, a special word of thanks to the parish office staff: they put in an enormous amount of extra effort without which the visit of the relics would not have been possible.

None of us (including me) knew quite what to expect from the Virtual Pilgrimages, but they were remarkably well-done. A number of parishioners have told me how meaningful they found the Virtual Pilgrimage to be. We are all deeply appreciative for the efforts of Jim and Pam Barton and Kathy Schultz who traveled to Greenwood to offer these pilgrimages. These folks belong to an organization known as the Our Lady of Lourdes Hospitality/North American Volunteers. In addition to offering Virtual Pilgrimages such as we experienced, the Volunteers also take people, particularly the sick, on pilgrimages to Lourdes in France. Anyone, however, is welcome to go on one of their pilgrimages. Incidentally, they are always looking for medical personnel (doctors, nurses, etc.) to accompany them and assist them with caring for sick pilgrims. They also take teenagers and provide them with opportunities for catechesis and the corporal work of mercy of caring for the sick. For over two years the state correctional institutions across the State of South Carolina have been closed to family members, visitors, and volunteers. They are expected to finally reopen in late May or early June. These imprisoned men and women are God's children and we have been directed to serve their needs, to bring God's word to them through example and deeds, to be their Christian companions. Deacon John Leininger, Coordinator for Prison Ministry Volunteers in the Diocese is going to hold a Zoom meeting (<https://clemson.zoom.us/j/97182951808>) on Tuesday, May 24, at 7:00 PM to rekindle the spirit of past volunteers and to orientate any new people wishing to volunteer to serve God in this unique ministry. He will cover the do's and don'ts on serving in prison ministry, strategies to work with the chaplains, resources that are available to help them in their ministry inside the institution, and resources available from organizations to help bring literature, rosaries, Bibles, and Christian movies into the system.
