

May 21, 2023 The Ascension of the Lord

Dear Our Lady of Lourdes family,

This Sunday we celebrate The Ascension of Our Lord Jesus into heaven. The ascent of Christ into heaven happens on the 40th day after his Resurrection. The meaning of the Ascension for Christians is derived from the belief in the glorification and exaltation of Jesus following his death and Resurrection, as well as from the theme of his return to God the Father. The holy gospels use both the sayings of Jesus and his post-Resurrection appearances to indicate a new relationship between Jesus and his Father and between him and his followers.

According to the first chapter of The Acts of the Apostles, after appearing to the disciples on various occasions during a period of 40 days, Jesus was taken up in their presence and was then hidden from them by a cloud, a frequent biblical image signifying the presence of God (Acts 1:9). One of the central themes of the feast of the Ascension is the kingship of Christ, and the theological implication is that the Ascension was the final redemptive act conferring participation in the divine life on all who are members of Christ. In other words, Christ was lifted up into heaven so that he might make us partakers of his Divinity.

Let us celebrate the feast of the Ascension by seeking to follow the example of the first disciples and witness to everyone the new life Our Lord offers in his resurrection and the promise of entry into his heavenly kingdom when he returns in glory.

Querida familia de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes,

Este domingo celebramos La Ascensión de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo al cielo. La fiesta de la ascensión de Cristo al cielo ocurre 40 días después de su Resurrección. El significado de la Ascensión para los cristianos se deriva de la creencia en la glorificación y exaltación de Jesús después de su muerte y resurrección, así como del tema de su regreso a Dios Padre. Los santos evangelios usan tanto los dichos de Jesús como sus apariciones posteriores a la Resurrección para indicar una nueva relación entre Jesús y su Padre y entre él y sus seguidores.

Según el primer capítulo de Los Hechos de los Apóstoles, después de aparecerse a los discípulos en varias ocasiones durante un período de 40 días, Jesús fue elevado en presencia de los discípulos y luego desaparece de ellos en una nube, imagen bíblica frecuente que significa la presencia de Dios (Hechos 1:9). Uno de los temas centrales de la fiesta de la Ascensión es la realeza de Cristo, y la implicación teológica es que la Ascensión fue el acto redentor final que confirió participación en la vida divina a todos los que son miembros de Cristo. En otras palabras, Cristo fue elevado al cielo para hacernos partícipes de su Divinidad.

Celebremos la fiesta de la Ascensión buscando seguir el ejemplo de los primeros discípulos y testimoniar a todos la vida nueva que Nuestro Señor ofrece en su resurrección y la promesa de entrar en su reino celestial cuando regrese en gloria.
